Infinitive	<b>to halse</b>
Present Tense	<b>halse / halses</b>
Past Tense	<b>halsed</b>
Present Participle	<b>halsing</b>
Past Participle	<b>halsed</b>

## **Conjugate Halse**

### **Halse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular          Plural**

I **halse**                  We **halse**  
You **halse**              You **halse**  
He/She/It **halses**    They **halse**

### **Halse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am halsing**              We **are halsing**  
You **are halsing**        You **are halsing**  
He/She/It **is halsing**    They **are halsing**

### **Halse in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have halsed**              We **have halsed**  
You **have halsed**        You **have halsed**  
He/She/It **has halsed**    They **have halsed**

### **Halse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been halsing**        We **have been halsing**  
You **have been halsing**    You **have been halsing**  
He/She/It **has been halsing**    They **have been halsing**

### **Halse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **halsed**                  We **halsed**  
You **halsed**              You **halsed**  
He/She/It **halsed**        They **halsed**

### **Halse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was halsing**                      We **were halsing**  
You **were halsing**                You **were halsing**  
He/She/It **was halsing**        They **were halsing**

**Halse in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had halsed**                        We **had halsed**  
You **had halsed**                    You **had halsed**  
He/She/It **had halsed**        They **had halsed**

**Halse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **had been halsing**                We **had been halsing**  
You **had been halsing**            You **had been halsing**  
He/She/It **had been halsing**    They **had been halsing**

I **will halse**                         We **will halse**  
You **will halse**                      You **will halse**  
He/She/It **will halse**            They **will halse**

I **will be halsing**                    We **will be halsing**  
You **will be halsing**                You **will be halsing**  
He/She/It **will be halsing**        They **will be halsing**

**I will have halsed**

**We will have halsed**

**You will have halsed**

**You will have halsed**

**He/She/It will have halsed**

**They will have halsed**

**I will have been halsing**

**We will have been halsing**

**You will have been halsing**

**You will have been halsing**

**He/She/It will have been halsing**
