## Associations of "Hand to mouth" (30 Words)

<b>cheek</b>	Either side of the face below the eye. <i>Gabriel had to bite his <b>cheeks</b> to keep from laughing.</i>
<b>chew</b>	A chewy sweet. <i>She <b>chewed</b> at a fingernail.</i>
<b>chewing</b>	Biting and grinding food in your mouth so it becomes soft enough to swallow.
<b>chin</b>	Raise oneself while hanging from one's hands until one's chin is level with the support bar. <i>He looked about ready to <b>chin</b> someone.</i>
<b>choking</b>	The act of suffocating (someone) by constricting the windpipe. <i>No evidence that the <b>choking</b> was done by the accused.</i>
<b>chomp</b>	Munch or chew noisily or vigorously. <i>She <b>chomped</b> on a roll.</i>
<b>dentist</b>	A person qualified to practice dentistry. <i>His mouth is still sore from his visit to the <b>dentist</b> s.</i>
<b>epiglottis</b>	A flap of cartilage behind the root of the tongue, which is depressed during swallowing to cover the opening of the windpipe.
<b>forehead</b>	The part of the face above the eyes.
<b>gargle</b>	Utter with gargling or burbling sounds. <i>A <b>gargle</b> for sore throats.</i>
<b>gnash</b>	(of teeth) strike together; grind. <i>The dog's jaws were primed to <b>gnash</b>.</i>
<b>gum</b>	Cover fill fix or smear with or as if with gum. <i>These trees <b>gum</b> in the Spring.</i>
<b>halitosis</b>	Offensive breath.
<b>hyoid</b>	Relating to the hyoid or structures associated with it.

<b>implant</b>	Provide someone or something with something by implantation. <i>A silicone breast <b>implant</b>.</i>
<b>jaw</b>	The lower movable bone of the jaw or the part of the face containing it. <i>I was too busy to spend time <b>jawing</b> with the rest of the crew.</i>
<b>lengthiness</b>	Amount or degree or range to which something extends.
<b>lingua</b>	A mobile mass of muscular tissue covered with mucous membrane and located in the oral cavity.
<b>lip</b>	(of the ball) hit the rim of (a hole) but fail to go in. <i>The <b>lip</b> of the cup.</i>
<b>mastication</b>	Biting and grinding food in your mouth so it becomes soft enough to swallow.
<b>molar</b>	Grinding tooth with a broad crown located behind the premolars. <i>Such <b>molar</b> problems of personality as the ego functions.</i>
<b>orthodontics</b>	The branch of dentistry dealing with the prevention or correction of irregularities of the teeth.
<b>puppet</b>	A small figure of a person operated from above with strings by a puppeteer. <i>A former revolutionary hero who is now a <b>puppet</b> of the state.</i>
<b>spit</b>	The act of spitting forcefully expelling saliva. <i>He was <b>spitting</b> with sudden fury.</i>
<b>stifler</b>	A person who stifles or smothers or suppresses. <i>He is a real conversation <b>stifler</b>.</i>
<b>throat</b>	The part of an animal's body that corresponds to a person's throat. <i>A gold pendant gleamed at her <b>throat</b>.</i>
<b>tongue</b>	Sound a note distinctly on a wind instrument by interrupting the air flow with the tongue. <i>The other horse <b>tongued</b> every part of the colt's mane.</i>
<b>tooth</b>	Something resembling the tooth of an animal. <i>The paper used in copying machines is good as it has <b>tooth</b> and takes ink well.</i>
<b>toothpaste</b>	A dentifrice in the form of a paste. <i>Fluoride <b>toothpastes</b>.</i>
<b>ventriloquist</b>	A performer who projects the voice into a wooden dummy.
