Handicap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I handicap We handicap

You handicap You handicap

He/She/It handicaps They handicap

Handicap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am handicapping We are handicapping
You are handicapping You are handicapping
He/She/It is handicapping They are handicapping

Handicap in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have handicapped We have handicapped You have handicapped He/She/It has handicapped They have handicapped

Handicap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been handicapping

You have been handicapping

You have been handicapping

He/She/It has been handicapping

They have been handicapping

Handicap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I handicapped We handicapped
You handicapped You handicapped
He/She/It handicapped They handicapped

Handicap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was handicapping We were handicapping
You were handicapping You were handicapping
He/She/It was handicapping They were handicapping

Handicap in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had handicapped We had handicapped
You had handicapped You had handicapped
He/She/It had handicapped They had handicapped

Handicap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been handicapping We had been handicapping
You had been handicapping You had been handicapping
He/She/It had been handicapping They had been handicapping

Handicap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **will handicap**You **will handicap**He/She/It **will handicap**They **will handicap**

Handicap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be handicapping
You will be handicapping
He/She/It will be handicapping
They will be handicapping

Handicap in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have handicapped We will have handicapped You will have handicapped He/She/It will have handicapped They will have handicapped

Handicap in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been handicapping
You will have been handicapping
He/She/It will have been handicapping
They will have been handicapping
