Definitions of "Handyman" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “handyman” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A man skilled in various odd jobs and other small tasks.*
- *A person able or employed to do occasional domestic repairs and minor renovations.*



Synonyms of "Handyman" as a noun (4 Words)

- factotum** An employee who does all kinds of work.
*He was employed as the general **factotum**.*
- jack of all trades** Tool for exerting pressure or lifting.
- man of all work** Someone who serves in the armed forces; a member of a military force.
- odd-job man** An adult person who is male (as opposed to a woman).
