Associations of "Hang out" (30 Words)

adjourn	(of a group of people) go somewhere for rest or refreshment. <i>Let s adjourn and reconvene at 2 o clock.</i>
ax	Chop or split with an ax. <i>Axe wood.</i>
axe	Cut or strike with an axe especially violently or destructively. <i>The Chancellor warned the cabinet to axe public spending.</i>
banner	A long strip of cloth bearing a slogan or design, carried in a demonstration or procession or hung in a public place. <i>The company was having a banner year.</i>
behead	Cut off the head of (someone), especially as a form of execution. <i>Mary was beheaded at Fotheringhay.</i>
bracelet	An ornamental band, hoop, or chain worn on the wrist or arm.
brooch	Fasten with or as if with a brooch.
cancel	A notation cancelling a previous sharp or flat. <i>A cancel title page.</i>
chandelier	Branched lighting fixture; often ornate; hangs from the ceiling.
cling	A clingstone peach. <i>Sucker like discs help them to cling on.</i>
dangle	Cause to dangle or hang freely. <i>The ornaments dangled from the tree.</i>
defer	Hold back to a later time. <i>He was no longer deferred from the draft.</i>
delay	An electronic device which introduces a delay especially in an audio signal. <i>Time being of the essence they delayed no longer.</i>
earring	A piece of jewellery worn on the lobe or edge of the ear.
execution	Seizure of the property or person of a debtor in default of payment. <i>Sixty seven executions were ordered against goods.</i>

exhale	Breathe out. <i>She sat back and exhaled deeply.</i>
flag	Provide or decorate with a flag or flags. <i>Problems often flag the need for organizational change.</i>
gibbet	Hang up a body on a gibbet. <i>The four ringleaders were sentenced to the gibbet.</i>
incomplete	Not yet finished. <i>Incomplete carvings of cattle.</i>
lamppost	A metal post supporting an outdoor lamp (such as a streetlight).
pearl	A very pale bluish grey or white colour like that of a pearl. <i>The sweat stood in pearls along his forehead.</i>
pendant	A necklace with a pendant. <i>Pendant flowers on frail stems.</i>
pendent	Branched lighting fixture; often ornate; hangs from the ceiling. <i>The use of jurisdiction to decide pendent claims.</i>
pillory	Put someone in a pillory. <i>He found himself pilloried by members of his own party.</i>
postpone	Hold back to a later time. <i>The visit had to be postponed for some time.</i>
reliant	Relying on another for support. <i>The company is heavily reliant on the baby market.</i>
scaffold	A structure made using scaffolding. <i>Scaffold boards.</i>
suspend	Render temporarily ineffective. <i>The prison sentence was suspended.</i>
swing	An act of swinging. <i>The party went with a swing.</i>
unsolved	Not solved. <i>Many crimes remain unsolved.</i>
