## The Forms of Hang

Infinitive	<b>to hang</b>
Present Tense	<b>hang / hangs</b>
Past Tense	<b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>
Present Participle	<b>hanging</b>
Past Participle	<b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>

## Conjugate Hang

### Hang in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>hang</b>	We <b>hang</b>
You <b>hang</b>	You <b>hang</b>
He/She/It <b>hangs</b>	They <b>hang</b>

## **Hang in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am hanging</b>	We <b>are hanging</b>
You <b>are hanging</b>	You <b>are hanging</b>
He/She/It <b>is hanging</b>	They <b>are hanging</b>

## **Hang in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>	We <b>have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>
You <b>have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>	You <b>have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>
He/She/It <b>has hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>	They <b>have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>

## **Hang in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been hanging</b>	We <b>have been hanging</b>
You <b>have been hanging</b>	You <b>have been hanging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been hanging</b>	They <b>have been hanging</b>

## **Hang in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>	We <b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>
You <b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>	You <b>hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)</b>

**Singular**

He/She/It **hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**Plural**

They **hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

### **Hang in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **was hanging**

You **were hanging**

He/She/It **was hanging**

**Plural**

We **were hanging**

You **were hanging**

They **were hanging**

### **Hang in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

You **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

He/She/It **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**Plural**

We **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

You **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

They **had hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

### **Hang in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I **had been hanging**

You **had been hanging**

He/She/It **had been hanging**

**Plural**

We **had been hanging**

You **had been hanging**

They **had been hanging**

### **Hang in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will hang**

You **will hang**

He/She/It **will hang**

**Plural**

We **will hang**

You **will hang**

They **will hang**

## Hang in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

### Singular

**I will be hanging**

**You will be hanging**

**He/She/It will be hanging**

### Plural

**We will be hanging**

**You will be hanging**

**They will be hanging**

## Hang in Future Perfect Tense

### Singular

**I will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**You will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**He/She/It will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

### Plural

**We will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**You will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

**They will have hung or hanged (mostly archaic and legal - see usage)**

## Hang in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

### Singular

**I will have been hanging**

**You will have been hanging**

**He/She/It will have been hanging**

### Plural

**We will have been hanging**

**You will have been hanging**

**They will have been hanging**
