They **harken**

Harken in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am harkening**

We **are harkening**

You **are harkening**

You **are harkening**

He/She/It **is harkening**

They **are harkening**

Harken in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

I **have harkened**

We **have harkened**

You **have harkened**

You **have harkened**

He/She/It **has harkened**

They **have harkened**

I **have been harkening**

We **have been harkening**

You **have been harkening**

You **have been harkening**

He/She/It **has been harkening**

They **have been harkening**

I **harkened**

We **harkened**

You **harkened**

You **harkened**

He/She/It **harkened**

Harken in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I was harkening We were harkening
You were harkening You were harkening
He/She/It was harkening They were harkening

Harken in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

I had harkened We had harkened
You had harkened You had harkened
He/She/It had harkened They had harkened

Harken in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been harkening We had been harkening
You had been harkening You had been harkening
He/She/It had been harkening They had been harkening

Harken in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will harken We will harken
You will harken You will harken
He/She/It will harken They will harken

Harken in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be harkening We will be harkening
You will be harkening You will be harkening
He/She/It will be harkening They will be harkening

Harken in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have harkened

We will have harkened

You will have harkened

You will have harkened

He/She/It will have harkened

They will have harkened

Harken in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been harkening

We will have been harkening

You will have been harkening

You will have been harkening

He/She/It will have been harkening

They will have been harkening
