Associations of "Has" (30 Words)

acquire	Take on a certain form, attribute, or aspect. <i>I acquired a strong aversion to television.</i>
acquisition	An ability that has been acquired by training. <i>The acquisition of self control.</i>
approbation	Official approval. <i>A term of approbation.</i>
attainable	Capable of being attained or accomplished. <i>Yields in excess of 6 are easily attainable.</i>
belong	Be a part or adjunct. <i>He put the rifle back in the locker where it belonged.</i>
checkbook	A book issued to holders of checking accounts.
earn	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. <i>She earns a lot in her new job.</i>
fetch	The action of fetching. <i>The dog fetches the hat.</i>
grab	A mechanical device for clutching, lifting, and moving things, especially materials in bulk. <i>He made a grab for the ball before it landed.</i>
hold	Have room for hold without crowding. <i>The auditorium can t hold more than 500 people.</i>
holder	A smallholder. <i>A towel holder.</i>
host	A person who acts as host at formal occasions makes an introductory speech and introduces other speakers. <i>Your host is Stuart Macmillan.</i>
incur	Receive a specified treatment (abstract). <i>I will pay any expenses incurred.</i>

landlady	A woman who keeps lodgings, a boarding house, or a pub.
landlord	A man who keeps lodgings, a boarding house, or a pub.
let	A brutal terrorist group active in Kashmir; fights against India with the goal of restoring Islamic rule of India. <i>Let it be.</i>
obtain	Be valid, applicable, or true. <i>How did you obtain the visa.</i>
own	Have something as one's own possess. <i>A state owned company.</i>
owner	Someone who owns (is legal possessor of) a business. <i>They are searching for the owner of the car.</i>
permission	Approval to do something. <i>He asked permission to leave.</i>
possess	Have ownership or possession of. <i>I was possessed by a desire to tell her everything.</i>
possession	The trait of resolutely controlling your own behavior. <i>I had no money or possessions.</i>
possessor	A person who owns something or has a particular quality. <i>His father was the possessor of a considerable fortune.</i>
procure	Cause (something) to happen. <i>He haunted railway stations to procure young girls for immoral purposes.</i>
property	Shares or investments in property. <i>He is a man of property.</i>
proprietor	The owner of a business, or a holder of property. <i>By 1640 he was himself the proprietor of a three hundred acre tract.</i>
regain	Come upon after searching; find the location of something that was missed or lost. <i>He soon regained his composure.</i>
rent	Hold under a lease or rental agreement of goods and services. <i>Let's rent a car.</i>
retention	The power of retaining liquid. <i>Eating too much salt can lead to fluid retention.</i>
take	Take on a certain form attribute or aspect. <i>He only takes size 5 boots.</i>
