acupuncture	Treatment of pain or disease by inserting the tips of needles at specific points on the skin.
advice	Information; news. <i>The want of fresh advices from Europe.</i>
adviser	An expert who gives advice. <i>The military adviser to the President.</i>
advisor	An expert who gives advice. <i>The United States sent military advisors to Guatemala.</i>
<u>apologist</u>	A person who offers an argument in defence of something controversial. <i>An enthusiastic apologist for fascism in the 1920s.</i>
<u>apprise</u>	Inform (somebody) of something. <i>I thought it right to apprise Chris of what had happened.</i>
chiroprapist	A person who treats the feet and their ailments. <i>She decided to train as a chiroprapist.</i>

consultant	An expert who gives advice. A consultant paediatrician.
counsel	Give professional help and advice to (someone) to resolve personal or psychological problems. The counsel for the defence.
counselor	Someone who has supervisory duties at a summer camp.
cure	A medicine or therapy that cures disease or relieve pain. This technology could be used to cure diabetes.
doctor	Treat (someone) medically. The dog was doctored .
faith	A strong belief in a supernatural power or powers that control human destiny. Keep the faith .
guidance	Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of action. He looked to his father for inspiration and guidance .
hortatory	Giving strong encouragement. A series of hortatory epistles.
illness	A disease or period of sickness affecting the body or mind. I ve never missed a day s work through illness .
massage	Give a massage to. She massaged his sore back.
mentor	Serve as a teacher or trusted counselor. Mentoring should be encouraged.
monition	Cautionary advice about something imminent (especially imminent danger or other unpleasantness). A letter of admonition about the dangers of immorality.
osteopath	A therapist who manipulates the skeleton and muscles.
podiatrist	A specialist in care for the feet. If a toe has a discharge it is likely infected and needs to be treated by a podiatrist .
psychiatrist	A physician who specializes in psychiatry.
psychology	The mental factors governing a situation or activity. The psychology of child killers.
recommend	Express a good opinion of. Some doctors recommend putting a board under the mattress.

- sane** Marked by sound judgment.
*Appears to be completely **sane**.*
- schizophrenia** (in general use) a mentality or approach characterized by inconsistent or contradictory elements.
*Gibraltar's **schizophrenia** continues to be fed by colonial pride.*
- spiritual** Relating to religion or religious belief.
*A **spiritual** approach to life.*
- therapeutic** A medicine or therapy that cures disease or relieve pain.
