### Definitions of "Heartbroken" as an adjective

- *Suffering from overwhelming distress.*
- *Full of sorrow.*



## Synonyms of "Heartbroken" as an adjective (11 Words)

- anguished** Experiencing intense pain especially mental pain.  
*An **anguished** conscience.*
- brokenhearted** Full of sorrow.
- crushed** (of cloth or paper) creased or crumpled.  
***Crushed** velvet.*
- desolate** (of a place) uninhabited and giving an impression of bleak emptiness.  
*A **desolate** Pennine moor.*
- despairing** Arising from or marked by despair or loss of hope.  
*A **despairing** view of the world situation.*

<b>grief-stricken</b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<b>grieving</b>	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
<b>heartsick</b>	Full of sorrow. <i>Too <b>heartsick</b> to fight back.</i>
<b>inconsolable</b>	(of a person or their grief) not able to be comforted or alleviated. <i><b>Inconsolable</b> when her son died.</i>
<b>shattered</b>	Ruined or disrupted. <i>Our <b>shattered</b> dreams of peace and prosperity.</i>
<b>suffering</b>	Troubled by pain or loss. <i>A message of hope for <b>suffering</b> humanity.</i>
