Synonyms of "Heartbroken" as an adjective (11 Words)

anguished	Experiencing intense pain especially mental pain. An anguished conscience.
brokenhearted	Full of sorrow.
<u>crushed</u>	(of cloth or paper) creased or crumpled. Crushed velvet.
desolate	(of a place) uninhabited and giving an impression of bleak emptiness. A desolate Pennine moor.
despairing	Arising from or marked by despair or loss of hope. A despairing view of the world situation.



grief-stricken	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
grieving	Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.
heartsick	Full of sorrow. Too heartsick to fight back.
inconsolable	(of a person or their grief) not able to be comforted or alleviated. Inconsolable when her son died.
<u>shattered</u>	Ruined or disrupted. Our shattered dreams of peace and prosperity.
suffering	Troubled by pain or loss. A message of hope for suffering humanity.
