<b>excellent</b>	Very good; of the highest quality. <i>The lorry was in <b>excellent</b> condition.</i>
<b>first-class</b>	Very good; of the highest quality.
<b>first-rate</b>	Of the highest quality.
<b>glorious</b>	Having, worthy of, or bringing fame or admiration. <i>Our <b>glorious</b> literature.</i>
<b><u>godlike</u></b>	Being or having the nature of a god. <i>He is a noble figure of <b>godlike</b> magnanimity.</i>
<b>godly</b>	Devoutly religious; pious. <i>Leading a <b>godly</b> life.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Belonging to or derived from or associated with a divine power. <i>The <b>holy</b> month of Ramadan.</i>
<b>ideal</b>	Conforming to an ultimate standard of perfection or excellence embodying an ideal. <i>The swimming pool is <b>ideal</b> for a quick dip.</i>
<b><u>idyllic</u></b>	Like an idyll; extremely happy, peaceful, or picturesque. <i>An attractive hotel in an <b>idyllic</b> setting.</i>
<b><u>immortal</u></b>	Living forever; never dying or decaying. <i>The <b>immortal</b> children's classic <i>The Wind in the Willows</i>.</i>
<b>marvellous</b>	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>You have done a <b>marvellous</b> job.</i>
<b>perfect</b>	Of a tense denoting a completed action or a state or habitual action which began in the past The perfect tense is formed in English with have or has and the past participle as in they have eaten and they have been eating present perfect they had eaten past perfect and they will have eaten future perfect. <i>She was <b>perfect</b> in French.</i>
<b>seraphic</b>	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>He imagined a <b>seraphic</b> presence in the room.</i>
<b><u>stellar</u></b>	Indicating the most important performer or role. <i>A <b>stellar</b> cast had been assembled.</i>
<b><u>sublime</u></b>	Of very great excellence or beauty. <i>The <b>sublime</b> absurdity of the creative process.</i>

- wonderful** Inspiring delight, pleasure, or admiration; extremely good; marvellous.  
*The climate was **wonderful** all the year round.*

<u><b>creator</b></u>	A person or thing that brings something into existence. <i>Water the <b>creator</b> of climate and weather.</i>
