glorious	Having, worthy of, or bringing fame or admiration. <i>Our glorious literature.</i>
<u>godlike</u>	Being or having the nature of a god. <i>He is a noble figure of godlike magnanimity.</i>
godly	Devoutly religious; pious. Leading a godly life.
holy	Belonging to or derived from or associated with a divine power. The holy month of Ramadan.
ideal	Conforming to an ultimate standard of perfection or excellence embodying an ideal. The swimming pool is ideal for a quick dip.
<u>idyllic</u>	Like an idyll; extremely happy, peaceful, or picturesque. <i>An attractive hotel in an idyllic setting.</i>
<u>immortal</u>	Living forever; never dying or decaying. The immortal children s classic The Wind in the Willows.
marvellous	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>You have done a marvellous job.</i>
perfect	Of a tense denoting a completed action or a state or habitual action which began in the past The perfect tense is formed in English with have or has and the past participle as in they have eaten and they have been eating present perfect they had eaten past perfect and they will have eaten future perfect. <i>She was perfect in French.</i>
seraphic	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>He imagined a seraphic presence in the room.</i>
<u>stellar</u>	Indicating the most important performer or role. A stellar cast had been assembled.
<u>sublime</u>	Of very great excellence or beauty. The sublime absurdity of the creative process.

<u>creator</u>	A person or thing that brings something into existence. Water the creator of climate and weather.
<u>devout</u>	Deeply religious. A rabbi s devout prayers.
<u>divine</u>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The divine strength of Achilles.</i>
<u>divinity</u>	The study of religion; theology. Ancient Egyptians believed in the divinity of the Pharaohs.
elysian	Relating to the Elysian Fields. An elysian meal.
<u>ethereal</u>	Of or containing or dissolved in ether. <i>Her ethereal beauty.</i>
firmament	The heavens or sky. Thunder shakes the firmament .
godly	Devoutly religious; pious. A godly man.
hallowed	Greatly revered and honoured. Jerusalem s hallowed soil.
heaven	Used in various exclamations as a substitute for 'God. Galileo used a telescope to observe the heaven s.
holy	Morally and spiritually excellent. <i>Holy</i> smoke.
omnipotent	Having great power and influence. God is described as omnipotent and benevolent.
omniscience	The state of knowing everything. <i>The notion of divine omniscience</i> .



<u>paradise</u>	The abode of Adam and Eve before the Fall in the biblical account of the Creation; the Garden of Eden. Martyrs who die in battle with the ungodly earn instant transmission to paradise .
<u>pious</u>	Dutiful or loyal, especially towards one's parents. <i>Pious</i> readings.
sacred	Regarded as too valuable to be interfered with; sacrosanct. The sacred mosque.
saintly	Relating to a saint. A truly saintly woman.
seraphic	Of or relating to an angel of the first order. <i>He imagined a seraphic presence in the room.</i>
supernal	Of exceptional quality or extent. The supernal happiness of a quiet death.
welkin	The apparent surface of the imaginary sphere on which celestial bodies appear to be projected.
