jinx One was never to wish luck to someone going hunting or fishing as it

was seen as a jinx.

A conjuror.

magician

oath

A commitment to tell the truth especially in a court of law to lie under

oath is to become subject to prosecution for perjury.

He exploded with a mouthful of **oath**s.

sorceress A woman sorcerer.

whammy A serious or devastating setback.

The third **whammy** was the degradation of the financial system.

witch A follower or practitioner of Wicca or of modern witchcraft.


He can marry the old **witch** for all I care.

Cast an evil spell on. witch


Mrs Mucharski had somehow witched the house.
