- *A magic spell; a curse.*
- *An evil spell.*
- *A witch.*



Synonyms of "Hex" as a noun (11 Words)

curse	Menstruation. <i>At every blow there was a curse.</i>
execration	Hate coupled with disgust.
fairy	Offensive term for a homosexual man. <i>Fairy gold.</i>
fairy godmother	Offensive term for an openly homosexual man.
imprecation	A spoken curse. <i>I pushed my way through screaming imprecations.</i>
jinx	A person or thing that brings bad luck. <i>One was never to wish luck to someone going hunting or fishing as it was seen as a jinx.</i>
<u>magician</u>	A conjuror. <i>He was the magician of the fan belt.</i>

oath

A commitment to tell the truth especially in a court of law to lie under oath is to become subject to prosecution for perjury.

*He exploded with a mouthful of **oaths**.*

sorceress

A woman sorcerer.

whammy

A serious or devastating setback.

*The third **whammy** was the degradation of the financial system.*

witch

A follower or practitioner of Wicca or of modern witchcraft.

*He can marry the old **witch** for all I care.*

Definitions of "Hex" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "hex" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Cast a spell on; bewitch.*
- *Cast a spell over someone or something; put a hex on someone or something.*



Synonyms of "Hex" as a verb (7 Words)

Cast a spell over someone or something; put a hex on someone or something.

*A handsome prince who had been **bewitched** by a sorceress.*

cast a spell on Put or send forth.

[enchant](#)

Hold spellbound.

*The scenery began to **enchant** her.*

glamour

Cast a spell over someone or something; put a hex on someone or something.

jinx

Foredoom to failure.

*The play is **jinxed**.*

put a spell on Arrange thoughts, ideas, temporal events.

witch

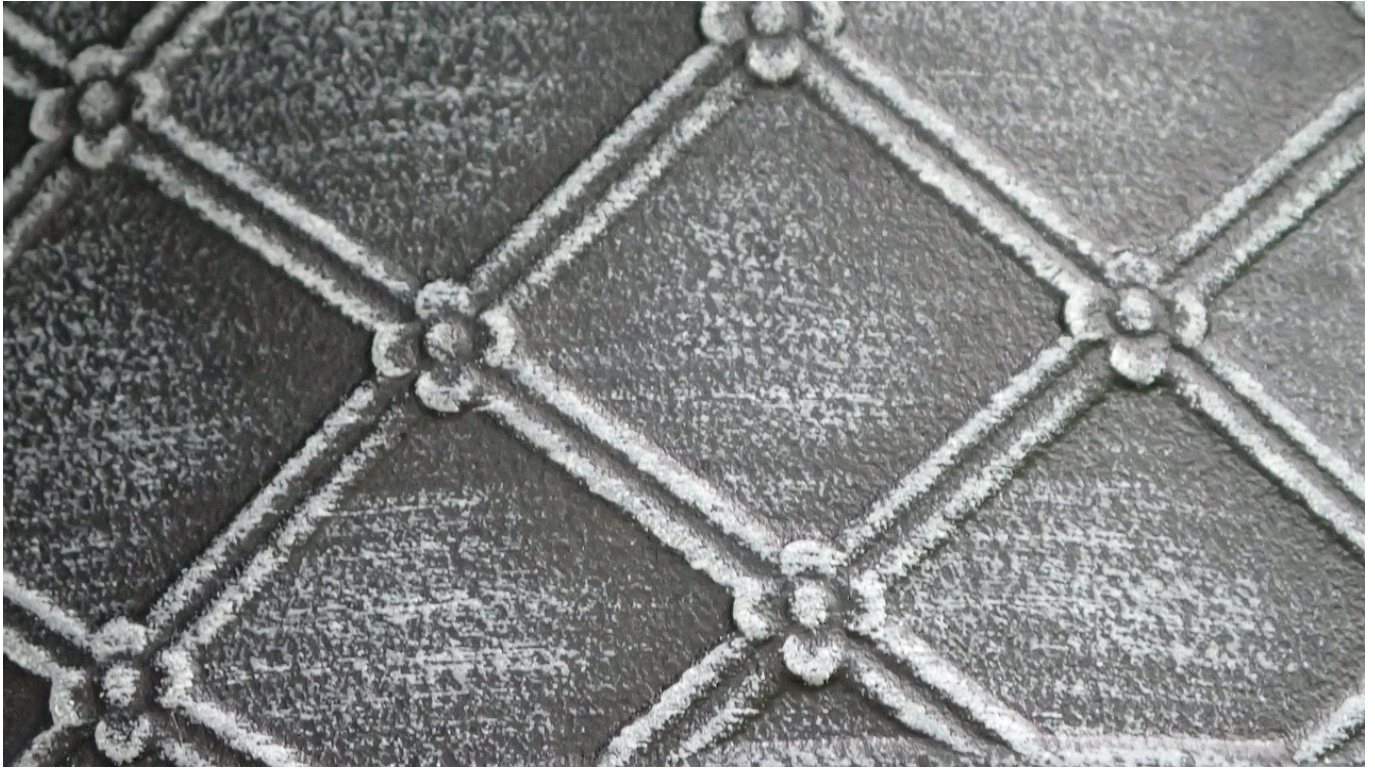
Cast an evil spell on.

*Mrs Mucharski had somehow **witched** the house.*

- *He hexed her with his fingers.*

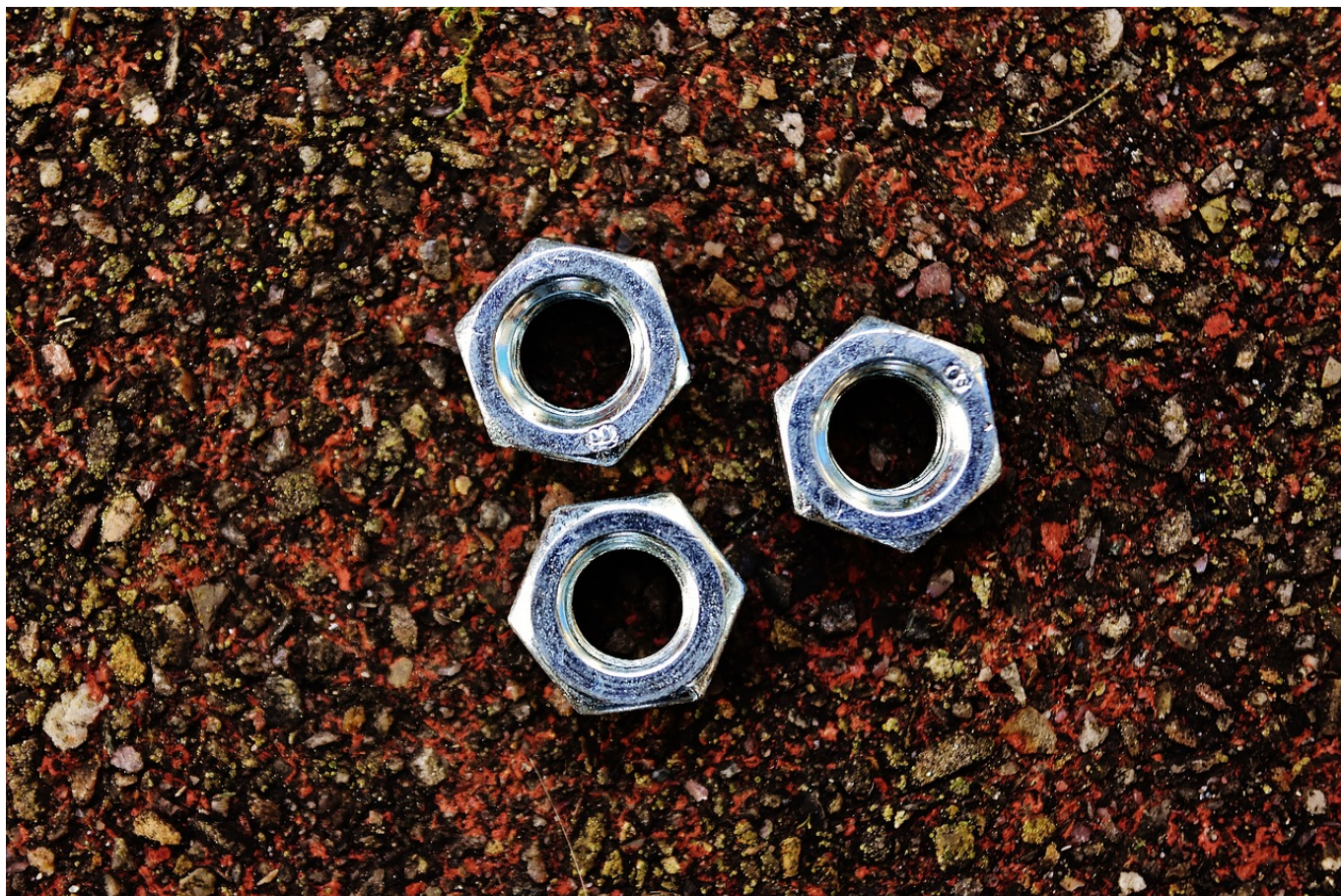


Hex as an Adjective
