Infinitive	to hiccup
Present Tense	hiccup / hiccups
Past Tense	hiccuped or hiccupped
Present Participle	hiccuping or hiccupping
Past Participle	hiccuped or hiccupped

Conjugate Hiccup

Hiccup in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I hiccup	We hiccup
You hiccup	You hiccup
He/She/It hiccups	They hiccup

Hiccup in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am hiccuping or hiccupping	We are hiccuping or hiccupping
You are hiccuping or hiccupping	You are hiccuping or hiccupping
He/She/It is hiccuping or hiccupping	They are hiccuping or hiccupping

Hiccup in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have hiccuped or hiccupped	We have hiccuped or hiccupped
You have hiccuped or hiccupped	You have hiccuped or hiccupped
He/She/It has hiccuped or hiccupped	They have hiccuped or hiccupped

Hiccup in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been hiccuping or hiccupping	We have been hiccuping or hiccupping
You have been hiccuping or hiccupping	You have been hiccuping or hiccupping
He/She/It has been hiccuping or hiccupping	They have been hiccuping or hiccupping

Hiccup in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I hiccuped or hiccupped	We hiccuped or hiccupped
You hiccuped or hiccupped	You hiccuped or hiccupped
He/She/It hiccuped or hiccupped	They hiccuped or hiccupped



Hiccup in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was hiccuping or hiccupping	We were hiccuping or hiccupping
You were hiccuping or hiccupping	You were hiccuping or hiccupping
He/She/It was hiccuping or hiccupping	They were hiccuping or hiccupping

Hiccup in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had hiccuped or hiccupped	We had hiccuped or hiccupped
You had hiccuped or hiccupped	You had hiccuped or hiccupped
He/She/It had hiccuped or hiccupped	I They had hiccuped or hiccupped

Hiccup in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been hiccuping or hiccupping	We had been hiccuping or hiccupping
You had been hiccuping or hiccupping	You had been hiccuping or hiccupping
He/She/It had been hiccuping or hiccupping	J They had been hiccuping or hiccupping

Hiccup in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will hiccup	We will hiccup
You will hiccup	You will hiccup
He/She/It will hiccup	They will hiccup

Hiccup in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be hiccuping or hiccupping	We will be hiccuping or hiccupping
You will be hiccuping or hiccupping	You will be hiccuping or hiccupping
He/She/It will be hiccuping or hiccupping	They will be hiccuping or hiccupping



Hiccup in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have hiccuped or hiccupped	We will have hiccuped or hiccupped
You will have hiccuped or hiccupped	You will have hiccuped or hiccupped
He/She/It will have hiccuped or hiccupped	I They will have hiccuped or hiccupped

Hiccup in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been hiccuping or hiccupping	We will have been hiccuping or hiccupping
You will have been hiccuping or	You will have been hiccuping or
hiccupping	hiccupping
He/She/It will have been hiccuping or	They will have been hiccuping or
hiccupping	hiccupping
