## Hidden as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Hidden" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “hidden” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not accessible to view.*
- *Difficult to find.*
- *Kept out of sight; concealed.*
- *Designed to elude detection.*



## Synonyms of "Hidden" as an adjective (13 Words)

<b>camouflaged</b>	Made invisible by means of protective coloring.
<b>concealed</b>	Kept secret; hidden. A <b>concealed</b> weapon.
<b><u>covered</u></b>	Overlaid or spread or topped with or enclosed within something; sometimes used as a combining form. <b>Covered</b> wagons.
<b>disguised</b>	Having its true character concealed with the intent of misleading. Are all of your novels <b>disguised</b> autobiography.
<b><u>invisible</u></b>	Impossible or nearly impossible to see; imperceptible by the eye. <b>Invisible</b> rays.
<b>masked</b>	(of one's true character or feelings) concealed. <b>Masked</b> dancers.
<b>not visible</b>	Obvious to the eye.
<b><u>obscure</u></b>	Remote and separate physically or socially. An impulse to go off and fight certain <b>obscure</b> battles of his own spirit.
<b>out of sight</b>	Not allowed to continue to bat or run.
<b>secret</b>	Given in confidence or in secret. The <b>secret</b> compartment in the desk.
<b>unrevealed</b>	Not revealed; secret. Some feelings can run so deep that they are better left <b>unrevealed</b> .
<b><u>unseen</u></b>	Not seen or observed. It seemed she might escape <b>unseen</b> .
<b><u>veiled</u></b>	Wearing or covered by a veil. A <b>veiled</b> woman.





## Usage Examples of "Hidden" as an adjective

- *Hidden valleys.*
- *A hidden cave.*
- *Concealed (or hidden) damage.*
- *Hidden dangers.*
- *Her hidden feelings.*
- *A hidden room or place of concealment such as a priest hole.*



## Associations of "Hidden" (30 Words)

### cache

Store data in a cache memory.  
*He decided that they must **cache** their weapons.*

### cave

Hollow out as if making a cave or opening.  
*They say they **cave** for the adventure challenge and physical exercise.*



<b>clandestine</b>	Kept secret or done secretly, especially because illicit. <i><b>Clandestine</b> intelligence operations.</i>
<b>concealed</b>	Hidden on any grounds for any motive. <i><b>Concealed</b> or hidden damage.</i>
<b>concealment</b>	The activity of keeping something secret. <i>The <b>concealment</b> of the weapons.</i>
<b>covert</b>	Not openly acknowledged or displayed. <i><b>Covert</b> actions by the CIA.</i>
<b>crypt</b>	A small tubular gland, pit, or recess.
<b>den</b>	Of a wild animal live in a den. <i>A female mink had set up her <b>den</b> there.</i>
<b>disguised</b>	Concealed or obscured; made unrecognizable. <i>The <b>disguised</b> form of aggression available to the powerless against the powerful.</i>
<b>furtive</b>	Secret and sly or sordid. <i>They spent a <b>furtive</b> day together.</i>
<b>incognito</b>	With your identity concealed. <i>She is locked in her <b>incognito</b>.</i>
<b>infiltration</b>	Permeation of a liquid into something by filtration. <i>The <b>infiltration</b> of seawater through the lava.</i>
<b>invisible</b>	Invisible exports and imports. <i>He lounged in a doorway <b>invisible</b> in the dark.</i>
<b>lair</b>	A burial plot in a graveyard. <i>A group of adventurers stormed into his mountain <b>lair</b> and killed him.</i>
<b>operative</b>	(of a word) having the most significance in a phrase or sentence. <i>Wounds needing <b>operative</b> treatment.</i>
<b>secrecy</b>	The trait of keeping things secret. <i>The bidding is conducted in <b>secrecy</b>.</i>
<b>secret</b>	Of information given in confidence or in secret. <i>The resupply effort was probably kept <b>secret</b> from Congress.</i>
<b>secretive</b>	(of a person's expression or manner) having an enigmatic or conspiratorial quality. <i>A <b>secretive</b> smile.</i>
<b>sensitization</b>	(psychology) the process of becoming highly sensitive to specific events or situations (especially emotional events or situations). <i>The aim of the activity was to develop <b>sensitization</b> to issues of diversity in the classroom.</i>

<b><u>sly</u></b>	Marked by skill in deception. <i>A <b>sly</b> manipulative woman.</i>
<b><u>sneak</u></b>	Someone who prowls or sneaks about usually with unlawful intentions. <i>He <b>sneaks</b> up on us slyly.</i>
<b><u>spy</u></b>	A secret watcher; someone who secretly watches other people. <i><b>Spy</b> for the Russians.</i>
<b><u>stealthy</u></b>	Behaving or done in a cautious and surreptitious manner, so as not to be seen or heard. <i><b>Stealthy</b> footsteps.</i>
<b><u>subterranean</u></b>	Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed)- Bertrand Russell. <i>The <b>subterranean</b> world of the behind the scenes television power brokers.</i>
<b><u>surreptitious</u></b>	Kept secret, especially because it would not be approved of. <i>Low wages were supplemented by <b>surreptitious</b> payments from tradesmen.</i>
<b><u>ulterior</u></b>	Lying beyond what is openly revealed or avowed (especially being kept in the background or deliberately concealed). <i>Could there be an <b>ulterior</b> motive behind his request.</i>
<b><u>undercover</u></b>	Conducted with or marked by hidden aims or methods. <i>He worked <b>undercover</b> in Northern Ireland.</i>
<b><u>underground</u></b>	A member of an underground political group or movement. <i><b>Underground</b> resistance.</i>
<b><u>underneath</u></b>	Partly or wholly concealed by a garment. <i>She seemed to have no emotions but in fact she was very sensitive <b>underneath</b>.</i>
<b><u>unopened</u></b>	Not opened. <i><b>Unopened</b> mail.</i>
