<b>giddy</b>	Excitable and frivolous. <i>A <b>giddy</b> precipice.</i>
<a href="#">height</a>	The point or period at which something is at its best or strongest. <i>It would be the <b>height</b> of bad manners not to attend the wedding.</i>
<b>ladder</b>	With reference to tights or stockings develop or cause to develop a ladder. <i>The first time I put them on one of the stockings <b>laddered</b>.</i>
<a href="#">lofty</a>	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. <i>A noble and <b>lofty</b> concept.</i>
<b>meridian</b>	Relating to or situated at a meridian. <i>The slow movements and postures of t ai chi open up and align the <b>meridians</b> of the body.</i>
<b>minaret</b>	Slender tower with balconies.
<a href="#">peak</a>	A brim that projects to the front to shade the eyes. <i>Voltage <b>peak</b>.</i>

<b>pinnacle</b>	Raise on or as if on a pinnacle. <i>He did not want to be <b>pinnacled</b>.</i>
<b>plateau</b>	An area of fairly level high ground. <i>The industry s problems have <b>plateaued</b> out.</i>
<b>raised</b>	Embellished with a raised pattern created by pressure or embroidery. <i>The lord and his family ate on a <b>raised</b> platform at one end of the hall.</i>
<b>rise</b>	Rise up. <i>The judge s remark heralded the signal for the court to <b>rise</b>.</i>
<b>rung</b>	A strengthening crosspiece in the structure of a chair. <i>We must ensure that the low skilled do not get trapped on the bottom <b>rung</b>.</i>
<b>skyscraper</b>	A very tall building with many stories.
<b>soaring</b>	Ascending to a level markedly higher than the usual. <i>The coloured trails of <b>soaring</b> rockets.</i>
<b>stepladder</b>	A short folding ladder with flat steps and a small platform.
<b>summit</b>	Reach the summit of a mountain. <i>The dramas are considered to form one of the <b>summits</b> of world literature.</i>
<b>tall</b>	A garment size for a tall person. <i><b>Tall</b> buildings.</i>
<b>top</b>	Provide with a top or topping. <i>The car has a <b>top</b> speed of 125 mph.</i>
<b>towering</b>	Of great importance or influence. <i><b>Towering</b> icebergs.</i>
<b>treble</b>	Sing treble. <i>The fish were caught with large <b>treble</b> hooks.</i>
<b>up</b>	Lift something up. <i>I m going for a walk <b>up</b> to the shops.</i>
<b>upper</b>	Higher in place or position. <i>The <b>upper</b> half of the class.</i>
<b>willowy</b>	(of a person) tall, slim, and lithe. <i><b>Willowy</b> meadow land.</i>
<b>zenith</b>	The highest point reached by a given celestial object. <i>The sun was well past the <b>zenith</b>.</i>
