altitude	The height of an object or point in relation to sea level or ground level. <i>Flight data including airspeed and altitude.</i>

elevated	Of high moral or intellectual value elevated in nature or style. <i>The elevated canon of great literary texts.</i>
elevation	The height of a dancer's leap or jump. <i>His elevation to cardinal.</i>
exalted	In a state of extreme happiness. <i>An exalted ideal.</i>
gangling	Tall and thin and having long slender limbs. <i>A gangling teenager.</i>
giddy	Excitable and frivolous. <i>A giddy precipice.</i>
height	The point or period at which something is at its best or strongest. <i>It would be the height of bad manners not to attend the wedding.</i>
ladder	With reference to tights or stockings develop or cause to develop a ladder. <i>The first time I put them on one of the stockings laddered.</i>
lofty	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. <i>A noble and lofty concept.</i>
meridian	Relating to or situated at a meridian. <i>The slow movements and postures of t ai chi open up and align the meridians of the body.</i>
minaret	Slender tower with balconies.
peak	A brim that projects to the front to shade the eyes. <i>Voltage peak.</i>

<u>pinnacle</u>	Raise on or as if on a pinnacle. <i>He did not want to be pinnacled.</i>
<u>plateau</u>	An area of fairly level high ground. <i>The industry s problems have plateaued out.</i>
raised	Embellished with a raised pattern created by pressure or embroidery. <i>The lord and his family ate on a raised platform at one end of the hall.</i>
rise	Rise up. <i>The judge s remark heralded the signal for the court to rise.</i>
rung	A strengthening crosspiece in the structure of a chair. <i>We must ensure that the low skilled do not get trapped on the bottom rung.</i>
skyscraper	A very tall building with many stories.
<u>soaring</u>	Ascending to a level markedly higher than the usual. <i>The coloured trails of soaring rockets.</i>
stepladder	A short folding ladder with flat steps and a small platform.
<u>summit</u>	Reach the summit of a mountain. <i>The dramas are considered to form one of the summits of world literature.</i>
tall	A garment size for a tall person. <i>Tall buildings.</i>
top	Provide with a top or topping. <i>The car has a top speed of 125 mph.</i>
towering	Of great importance or influence. <i>Towering icebergs.</i>
treble	Sing treble. <i>The fish were caught with large treble hooks.</i>
<u>up</u>	Lift something up. <i>I m going for a walk up to the shops.</i>
<u>upper</u>	Higher in place or position. <i>The upper half of the class.</i>
willowy	(of a person) tall, slim, and lithe. <i>Willowy meadow land.</i>
<u>zenith</u>	The highest point reached by a given celestial object. <i>The sun was well past the zenith.</i>
