- *The circumference of the body at the buttocks.*
- *The ball-and-socket joint between the head of the femur and the acetabulum.*
- *A person's hip joint.*
- *Either side of the body below the waist and above the thigh.*
- *A projection of the pelvis and upper thigh bone on each side of the body in human beings and quadrupeds.*
- *The exterior angle formed by the junction of a sloping side and a sloping end of a roof.*
- *(architecture) the exterior angle formed by the junction of a sloping side and a sloping end of a roof.*
- *The fruit of a rose plant.*
- *The structure of the vertebrate skeleton supporting the lower limbs in humans and the hind limbs or corresponding parts in other vertebrates.*

- *The sharp edge of a roof from the ridge to the eaves where the two sides meet.*

<b>hindquarters</b>	The fleshy part of the human body that you sit on.
<b>hip joint</b>	The fruit of a rose plant.
<b>pelvic arch</b>	A curved bony structure supporting or enclosing organs (especially the inner sides of the feet).
<b>pelvic girdle</b>	The structure of the vertebrate skeleton supporting the lower limbs in humans and the hind limbs or corresponding parts in other vertebrates.
<b>pelvis</b>	The part of the abdomen including or enclosed by the pelvis.
<b>posterior</b>	A person's buttocks.

<b>rear</b>	The side that goes last or is not normally seen. <i>Infantrymen were in the <b>rear</b>.</i>
<b>rose hip</b>	Any of many shrubs of the genus <i>Rosa</i> that bear roses.
<b>rosehip</b>	The fruit of a rose plant.
<b>thighs</b>	The upper joint of the leg of a fowl.

<b>ankle</b>	The narrow part of the leg between the ankle joint and the calf. <i>We can <b>ankle</b> off to a new locale.</i>
<b><u>arm</u></b>	A sleeve of a garment. <i>The political <b>arm</b> of the separatist group.</i>
<b>belt</b>	A conveyor belt. <i>A <b>belt</b> of trees.</i>
<b>buckle</b>	Fasten with a buckle or buckles. <i>He <b>buckled</b> his belt.</i>
<b>cartilage</b>	A particular structure made of cartilage. <i>His knees failed and the <b>cartilages</b> were removed.</i>
<b><u>chest</u></b>	Propel the ball by means of one's chest. <i>The medicine <b>chest</b>.</i>
<b>cleavage</b>	Cell division, especially of a fertilized egg cell. <i>All the cells divide synchronously for the first 12 <b>cleavages</b>.</i>
<b>dislocate</b>	Disturb the organization of; disrupt. <i>He <b>dislocated</b> his shoulder in training.</i>
<b>elbow</b>	Shove one's elbow into another person's ribs. <i>He <b>elbowed</b> his way through the crush.</i>
<b>epaulet</b>	Adornment consisting of an ornamental cloth pad worn on the shoulder.
<b>extensor</b>	A muscle whose contraction extends or straightens a limb or other part of the body.
<b><u>fracture</u></b>	A diphthong substituted by fracture. <i>A <b>fracture</b> of the left leg.</i>
<b>garter</b>	Fasten with or as if with a garter. <i>She leaned back showing the <b>garter</b> on her thigh.</i>
<b>holster</b>	Put a gun into its holster. <i>He <b>holstered</b> the Browning before walking back.</i>
<b>jaw</b>	The lower movable bone of the jaw or the part of the face containing it. <i>He <b>jawed</b> his bubble gum.</i>
<b>knee</b>	The joint in other animals that corresponds or is analogous to the human knee. <i>She <b>kneed</b> him in the groin.</i>
<b>kneecap</b>	Shoot in the kneecap often done by terrorist groups as a warning. <i>Petty crimes are punished by <b>kneecapping</b>.</i>
<b>lap</b>	A flap that lies over another part. <i>The cat <b>lapped</b> up the milk.</i>

<b>ligament</b>	A sheet or band of tough fibrous tissue connecting bones or cartilages or supporting muscles or organs.
<b>limb</b>	The circumferential edge of the apparent disc of the sun or the moon or a planet. <i>The upper <b>limb</b> of the bow.</i>
<b>mandible</b>	Either half of the crushing organ in an arthropod's mouthparts. <i>The drake is all black except for an orange mark on the upper <b>mandible</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>neck</u></a>	The length of a horse's head and neck as a measure of its lead in a race. <i>He'll be stuck with a loan around his <b>neck</b>.</i>
<b>sash</b>	A framework that holds the panes of a window in the window frame.
<b>shoulder</b>	A part of something resembling a shoulder in shape position or function. <i>She <b>shouldered</b> him brusquely aside.</i>
<b>sleeve</b>	Small case into which an object fits. <i>An album <b>sleeve</b>.</i>
<b>sprain</b>	Twist suddenly so as to sprain. <i>He left in a wheelchair after <b>spraining</b> an ankle.</i>
<b>waist</b>	The circumference of a person's waist. <i>Her <b>waist</b> has reduced from 35 to 28 inches.</i>
<b>waistline</b>	An imaginary line around a car or other vehicle at the level of the bottom of the windows. <i>The changing <b>waistline</b> in women's fashions.</i>
<b>wrist</b>	The part of a garment covering the wrist a cuff. <i>Elasticated <b>wrists</b> and ankles.</i>
