antiquarian	A person who studies or collects antiques or antiquities.
archivist	A person who maintains and is in charge of archives.
biographer	Someone who writes an account of a person's life. <i>An important biographer of contemporary artists.</i>
chronicler	A person who writes accounts of important or historical events. <i>A chronicler of 18th century American life.</i>
chronologist	A record of events in the order of their occurrence.
historiographer	A person who is an authority on history and who studies it and writes about it.
recorder	Equipment for making records. <i>A cockpit voice recorder.</i>

anthropologist	A social scientist who specializes in anthropology. <i>Some anthropologists think that members of hunting and gathering societies tend to have more leisure.</i>
archeologist	An anthropologist who studies prehistoric people and their culture.
archivist	A person who maintains and is in charge of archives.
<u>connoisseur</u>	An expert judge in matters of taste. <i>A connoisseur of music.</i>
<u>disciple</u>	A personal follower of Christ during his life, especially one of the twelve Apostles. <i>A disciple of Rousseau.</i>
economist	An expert in economics.
epistemologist	A specialist in epistemology.
futurist	Relating to a vision of the future. <i>Futurist art.</i>
genealogist	A person who traces or studies lines of family descent. <i>According to a genealogist she is the queen s 18th cousin.</i>
grammarian	A person who studies and writes about grammar.
<u>guru</u>	An influential teacher or popular expert. <i>A guru of genomics.</i>
mathematician	A person skilled in mathematics. <i>One of the world s foremost theoretical mathematicians.</i>
numismatist	A collector and student of money (and coins in particular.
ornithologist	A person who studies or is an expert on birds.
<u>philosopher</u>	A specialist in philosophy.
professional	Worthy of or appropriate to a professional person competent skilful or assured. <i>His first season as a professional.</i>
repository	A place where something, especially a natural resource, is found in significant quantities. <i>The metadata will be aggregated in a repository.</i>
<u>scholar</u>	A university student holding a scholarship. <i>Mr Bell declares himself no scholar.</i>

sinologist	A student of Chinese history and language and culture.
sociologist	An expert in or student of the development, structure, and functioning of human society. <i>Historians and sociologists are still split on the matter.</i>
sophist	A person who reasons with clever but false arguments.
specialist	Practices one branch of medicine. <i>Her doctor thought her allergy was psychosomatic but he sent her to a specialist.</i>
<u>specialize</u>	Confine oneself to providing a particular product or service. <i>She specializes in honey bees.</i>
statistician	An expert in the preparation and analysis of statistics.
study	A thing that is or deserves to be investigated the subject of an individual s study. <i>An application to continue full time study.</i>
syllogistic	Of or relating to or consisting of syllogism.
taxonomist	A biologist who specializes in the classification of organisms into groups on the basis of their structure and origin and behavior.
<u>university</u>	The body of faculty and students at a university. <i>His daughter is at university.</i>
