## **Conjugate Hitch**

### Hitch in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>hitch</b>	We <b>hitch</b>
You <b>hitch</b>	You <b>hitch</b>
He/She/It hitches	They hitch

## Hitch in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>am hitching</b>	We <b>are hitching</b>
You <b>are hitching</b>	You <b>are hitching</b>
He/She/It is hitching	They are hitching

#### **Hitch in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have hitched	We have hitched
You have hitched	You have hitched
He/She/It has hitched	They have hitched

## **Hitch in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been hitching	We have been hitching
You <b>have been hitching</b>	You have been hitching
He/She/It has been hitching	They have been hitching

## Hitch in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>hitched</b>	We <b>hitched</b>
You <b>hitched</b>	You <b>hitched</b>
He/She/It hitched	They <b>hitched</b>

## Hitch in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was hitching	We were hitching
You <b>were hitching</b>	You were hitching
He/She/It was hitching	They were hitching

#### **Hitch in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had hitched	We had hitched
You had hitched	You had hitched
He/She/It had hitched	They had hitched

### **Hitch in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been hitching	We had been hitching
You <b>had been hitching</b>	You had been hitching
He/She/It had been hitching	They had been hitching

## Hitch in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will hitch	We will hitch
You <b>will hitch</b>	You <b>will hitch</b>
He/She/It will hitch	They will hitch

## Hitch in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be hitching	We will be hitching
You <b>will be hitching</b>	You will be hitching
He/She/It will be hitching	They will be hitching

#### **Hitch in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been hitching	We <b>will have been hitching</b>
You <b>will have been hitching</b>	You <b>will have been hitching</b>
He/She/It will have been hitching	They will have been hitching
