Definitions of "Hog" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “hog” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A person regarded as greedy and pig-like.*
- *A large motorcycle, in particular a Harley Davidson.*
- *A domesticated pig, especially a castrated male reared for slaughter.*
- *A wild animal of the pig family, for example a warthog.*
- *A young sheep before the first shearing.*
- *A feral pig.*
- *A greedy person.*
- *Domestic swine.*
- *A sheep up to the age of one year; one yet to be sheared.*



Synonyms of "Hog" as a noun (11 Words)

- boar** The flesh of the wild boar as food.
- grunter** A person who grunts.
- hogg** A sheep up to the age of one year; one yet to be sheared.
- hogget** A lamb between weaning and first shearing.
- pig** A person regarded as greedy and pig like.
*Were the **pigs** there when the windows were smashed or not.*
- piglet** A young pig.
- porker** A pig fattened to provide meat.
- sow** An adult female hog.
- squealer** One who reveals confidential information in return for money.
*His chances of further employment have been damaged because some will view him as a **squealer**.*
- sus scrofa** Old World wild swine having a narrow body and prominent tusks from which most domestic swine come; introduced in United States.

*She had a herd of **swine**.*

Definitions of "Hog" as a verb

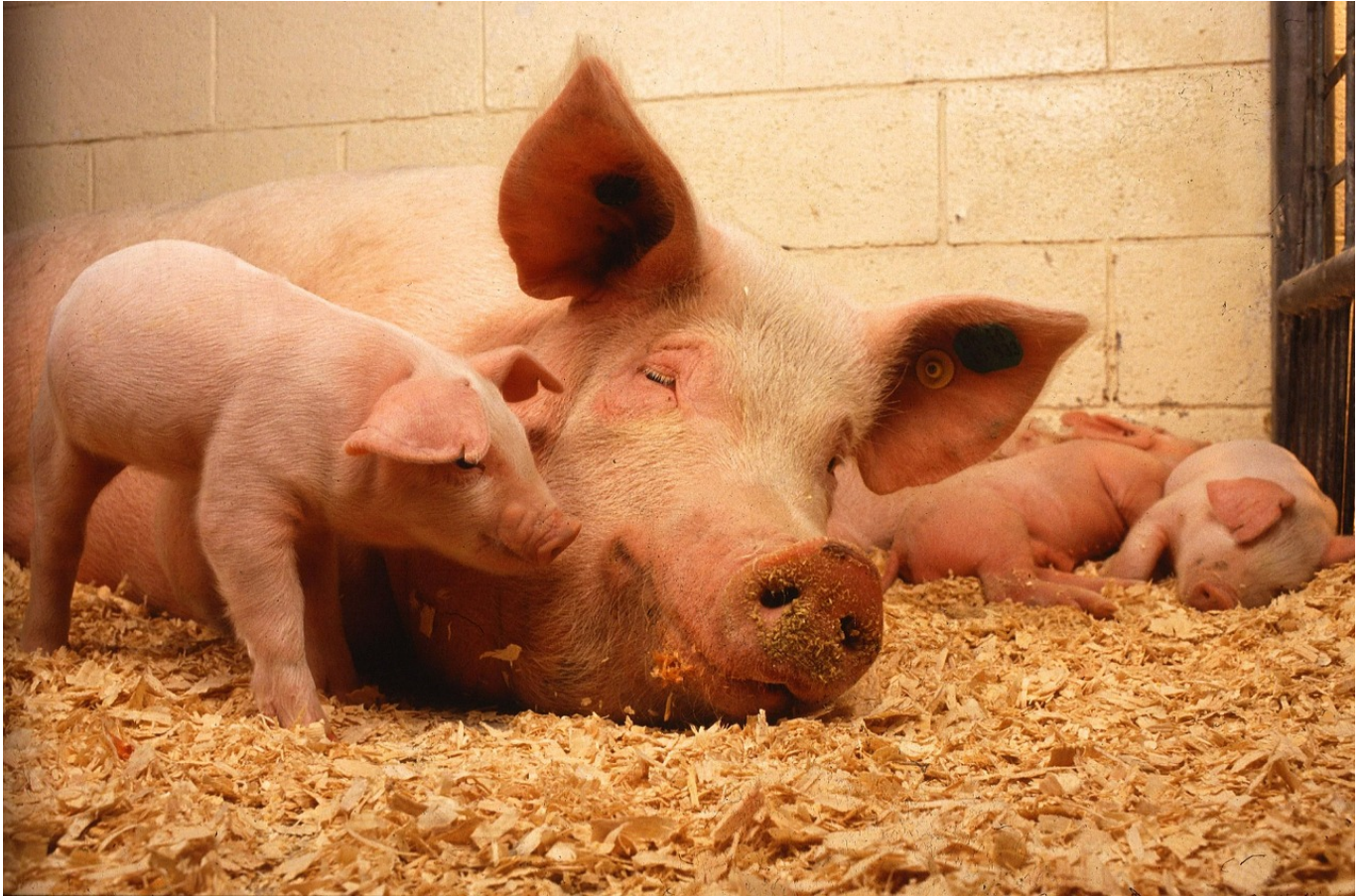
According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "hog" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Take or use most or all of (something) in an unfair or selfish way.*
- *Take greedily; take more than one's share.*
- *Cause (a ship or its keel) to curve up in the centre and sag at the ends as a result of strain.*



Synonyms of "Hog" as a verb (6 Words)

- control** Control others or oneself or influence skillfully usually to one's advantage.
***Control** your anger.*
- corner** Establish a corner in a commodity.
*You **cornered** vanadium and made a killing.*
- dominate** Have power and influence over.
*The race was **dominated** by the 1998 champion.*
- keep to oneself** Hold and prevent from leaving.
(of an organization or group) obtain exclusive possession or control of (a trade, commodity, or service).
- monopolize** *They instituted press censorship and **monopolized** the means of communication.*
- take over** Admit into a group or community.



Usage Examples of "Hog" as a verb

- *He never hogged the limelight.*
