- A young sheep before the first shearing.
- A feral pig.
- A greedy person.
- Domestic swine.
- A sheep up to the age of one year; one yet to be sheared.

grunter A person who grunts.

hogg A sheep up to the age of one year; one yet to be sheared.

porker A pig fattened to provide meat.

sow An adult female hog.

most domestic swine come; introduced in United States.

Definitions of "Hog" as a verb

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "hog" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Take or use most or all of (something) in an unfair or selfish way.
- Take greedily; take more than one's share.
- Cause (a ship or its keel) to curve up in the centre and sag at the ends as a result of strain.
