Homeschool in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **homeschool** We **homeschool**
You **homeschool** You **homeschool**
He/She/It **homeschools** They **homeschool**

Homeschool in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am homeschooling** We **are homeschooling**
You **are homeschooling** You **are homeschooling**
He/She/It **is homeschooling** They **are homeschooling**

Homeschool in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have homeschooled** We **have homeschooled**
You **have homeschooled** You **have homeschooled**
He/She/It **has homeschooled** They **have homeschooled**
