## Associations of "Honed" (30 Words)

<b>abrade</b>	Rub hard or scrub. <i>It was a landscape slowly <b>abraded</b> by a fine stinging dust.</i>
<b><u>abrasive</u></b>	Showing little concern for the feelings of others; harsh. <i>An <b>abrasive</b> character.</i>
<b>awl</b>	A small pointed tool used for piercing holes, especially in leather.
<b>ax</b>	Chop or split with an ax. <i>The NSF <b>axed</b> the research program and stopped funding it.</i>
<b>behead</b>	Cut the head of. <i>Mary was <b>beheaded</b> at Fotheringhay.</i>
<b><u>brace</u></b>	Support or hold steady and make steadfast with or as if with a brace. <i>He stood with legs <b>braced</b>.</i>
<b>chop</b>	Form or shape by chopping. <i>They <b>chopped</b> off all her hair.</i>
<b><u>craft</u></b>	An aircraft or spaceship. <i>A beautifully <b>crafted</b> object.</i>
<b>crush</b>	Crush or bruise. <i>I was <b>crushed</b> was I not good enough.</i>
<b>drudgery</b>	Hard monotonous routine work. <i>Domestic <b>drudgery</b>.</i>
<b>finely</b>	With a very sharp point. <i>A rod of <b>finely</b> sharpened iron.</i>
<b>flour</b>	Cover with flour. <i>Manioc <b>flour</b>.</i>
<b>grind</b>	Created by grinding. <i>He keeps me awake at night <b>grinding</b> his teeth.</i>
<b>grindstone</b>	A thick disc of stone or other abrasive material mounted so as to revolve, used for grinding, sharpening, or polishing metal objects.

<b>hammer</b>	Create by hammering. <i><b>Hammer</b> the silver into a bowl.</i>
<b>heighten</b>	Make more intense, stronger, or more marked. <i>The athletes kept jumping over the steadily <b>heightened</b> bars.</i>
<b>knife</b>	Stab someone with a knife. <i>The victim was <b>knifed</b> to death.</i>
<b>mash</b>	A mixture of mashed malt grains and hot water used in brewing. <i><b>Mash</b> the garlic.</i>
<b>mill</b>	Grind something in a mill. <i><b>Mill</b> a coin.</i>
<b>millstone</b>	Each of two circular stones used for grinding grain.
<b>pointed</b>	Having a point. <i>A <b>pointed</b> allusion to what was going on.</i>
<b>powder</b>	Apply cosmetic powder to the face or body. <i>She applied lipstick and <b>powder</b>.</i>
<b>pulverize</b>	Reduce to fine particles. <i>The brick of the villages was <b>pulverized</b> by the bombardment.</i>
<b>sharp</b>	Of a key having a sharp or sharps in the signature. <i>The road twists <b>sharply</b> after the light.</i>
<b>sharpen</b>	Make sharp or sharper. <i>They ve got to <b>sharpen</b> up in front of the goal.</i>
<b>shatter</b>	Break or cause to break suddenly and violently into pieces. <i>The window was <b>shattered</b> by a stone.</i>
<b>shred</b>	Tear or cut into shreds. <i>He really can <b>shred</b> that guitar.</i>
<b>squash</b>	Edible fruit of a squash plant eaten as a vegetable. <i>The mournful sound did nothing to <b>squash</b> her high spirits.</i>
<b>tamp</b>	A tool for tamping e g for tamping tobacco into a pipe bowl or a charge into a drill hole etc. <i>When the hole was <b>tamped</b> to the top gunpowder was inserted.</i>
<b>whet</b>	Sharpen by rubbing as on a whetstone. <i>The selection of quotations may <b>whet</b> your curiosity to investigate the source material.</i>
