chop	Form or shape by chopping. They chop ped off all her hair.
<u>craft</u>	An aircraft or spaceship. A beautifully craft ed object.
crush	Crush or bruise. I was crush ed was I not good enough.
drudgery	Hard monotonous routine work. Domestic drudgery .
finely	With a very sharp point. A rod of finely sharpened iron.
flour	Cover with flour. <i>Manioc flour.</i>
grind	Created by grinding. He keeps me awake at night grind ing his teeth.
grindstone	A thick disc of stone or other abrasive material mounted so as to revolve, used for grinding, sharpening, or polishing metal objects.



hammer	Create by hammering. <i>Hammer</i> the silver into a bowl.
heighten	Make more intense, stronger, or more marked. The athletes kept jumping over the steadily heighten ed bars.
<u>knife</u>	Stab someone with a knife. The victim was knife d to death.
mash	A mixture of mashed malt grains and hot water used in brewing. <i>Mash the garlic.</i>
mill	Grind something in a mill. <i>Mill a coin.</i>
millstone	Each of two circular stones used for grinding grain.
pointed	Having a point. A pointed allusion to what was going on.
powder	Apply cosmetic powder to the face or body. She applied lipstick and powder .
pulverize	Reduce to fine particles. The brick of the villages was pulverize d by the bombardment.
<u>sharp</u>	Of a key having a sharp or sharps in the signature. The road twists sharp ly after the light.
<u>sharpen</u>	Make sharp or sharper. They ve got to sharpen up in front of the goal.
shatter	Break or cause to break suddenly and violently into pieces. The window was shatter ed by a stone.
<u>shred</u>	Tear or cut into shreds. <i>He really can shred that guitar.</i>
<u>squash</u>	Edible fruit of a squash plant eaten as a vegetable. The mournful sound did nothing to squash her high spirits.
tamp	A tool for tamping e g for tamping tobacco into a pipe bowl or a charge into a drill hole etc. When the hole was tamp ed to the top gunpowder was inserted.
whet	Sharpen by rubbing as on a whetstone. The selection of quotations may whet your curiosity to investigate the source material.
