heighten Make more intense, stronger, or more marked.

knife Stab someone with a knife.

The victim was **knife**d to death.

mash A mixture of mashed malt grains and hot water used in brewing.

mill Grind with a mill.

millstone Each of two circular stones used for grinding grain.
