Associations of "Hoped" (30 Words)

aspiration	The action or process of drawing breath. <i>The needs and aspirations of the people.</i>
aspire	Have an ambitious plan or a lofty goal. <i>Above the domes of loftiest mosques these pinnacles aspire.</i>
covet	Yearn to possess (something, especially something belonging to another). <i>I covet one of their smart bags.</i>
covetous	Having or showing a great desire to possess something belonging to someone else. <i>Jealous of his success and covetous of his possessions.</i>
crave	Have a craving, appetite, or great desire for. <i>Will craved for family life.</i>
craving	An intense desire for some particular thing. <i>A craving for chocolate.</i>
desideratum	Something desired as a necessity. <i>Integrity was a desideratum.</i>
desire	Something that is desired. <i>John spake unto him and desired him in like manner and contestation as before.</i>
desirous	Having or characterized by desire. <i>The Pope was desirous of peace in Europe.</i>
eagerly	Used to emphasize a strong desire to do or have something. <i>Original illustrations are eagerly sought by collectors.</i>
envious	Feeling or showing envy. <i>An envious glance.</i>
expect	Consider obligatory request and expect. <i>We expect employers to pay a reasonable salary.</i>

grasping	Immoderately desirous of acquiring e.g. wealth. <i>They were regarded as grasping landlords.</i>
greedy	Immoderately desirous of acquiring e.g. wealth. <i>Don t be greedy with the cookies.</i>
hankering	A yearning for something or to do something. <i>A hankering for family life.</i>
hopeful	Having or manifesting hope. <i>Two executive hopefuls joined the firm.</i>
hopefully	In a hopeful manner. <i>He rode on hopefully.</i>
jealous	(of God) demanding faithfulness and exclusive worship. <i>She was always jealous of me.</i>
jealousy	Zealous vigilance-Paul Blanshard. <i>A sharp pang of jealousy.</i>
longing	Prolonged unfulfilled desire or need. <i>Miranda felt a wistful longing for the old days.</i>
lucky	Occurring by chance. <i>A lucky escape.</i>
optimistically	With optimism; in an optimistic manner. <i>He spoke optimistically about what is ahead.</i>
think	An instance of deliberate thinking. <i>Think of being paid a salary to hunt big game.</i>
unquenchable	Not able to be quenched. <i>His enthusiasm was unquenchable.</i>
want	Hunt or look for want for a particular reason. <i>He is wanted by the police in connection with an arms theft.</i>
willingness	The quality or state of being prepared to do something; readiness. <i>He expressed his willingness to help.</i>
wish	Order politely express a wish for. <i>I wish I could go home now.</i>
wishing	A specific feeling of desire. <i>He was above all wishing and desire.</i>
yearning	Involving or expressing yearning. <i>He felt a yearning for the mountains.</i>
zeal	Great energy or enthusiasm in pursuit of a cause or an objective. <i>He had an absolute zeal for litigation.</i>
