## Associations of "Hoped" (30 Words)

<a href="#">aspiration</a>	The action or process of drawing breath. <i>The needs and <b>aspirations</b> of the people.</i>
<a href="#">aspire</a>	Have an ambitious plan or a lofty goal. <i>Above the domes of loftiest mosques these pinnacles <b>aspire</b>.</i>
<a href="#">covet</a>	Yearn to possess (something, especially something belonging to another). <i>I <b>covet</b> one of their smart bags.</i>
<b>covetous</b>	Having or showing a great desire to possess something belonging to someone else. <i>Jealous of his success and <b>covetous</b> of his possessions.</i>
<a href="#">crave</a>	Have a craving, appetite, or great desire for. <i>Will <b>craved</b> for family life.</i>
<a href="#">craving</a>	An intense desire for some particular thing. <i>A <b>craving</b> for chocolate.</i>
<b>desideratum</b>	Something desired as a necessity. <i>Integrity was a <b>desideratum</b>.</i>
<b>desire</b>	Something that is desired. <i>John spake unto him and <b>desired</b> him in like manner and contestation as before.</i>
<b>desirous</b>	Having or characterized by desire. <i>The Pope was <b>desirous</b> of peace in Europe.</i>
<a href="#">eagerly</a>	Used to emphasize a strong desire to do or have something. <i>Original illustrations are <b>eagerly</b> sought by collectors.</i>
<a href="#">envious</a>	Feeling or showing envy. <i>An <b>envious</b> glance.</i>
<a href="#">expect</a>	Consider obligatory request and expect. <i>We <b>expect</b> employers to pay a reasonable salary.</i>

<b>grasping</b>	Immoderately desirous of acquiring e.g. wealth. <i>They were regarded as <b>grasping</b> landlords.</i>
<b>greedy</b>	Immoderately desirous of acquiring e.g. wealth. <i>Don t be <b>greedy</b> with the cookies.</i>
<b>hankering</b>	A yearning for something or to do something. <i>A <b>hankering</b> for family life.</i>
<b>hopeful</b>	Having or manifesting hope. <i>Two executive <b>hopefuls</b> joined the firm.</i>
<b>hopefully</b>	In a hopeful manner. <i>He rode on <b>hopefully</b>.</i>
<b>jealous</b>	(of God) demanding faithfulness and exclusive worship. <i>She was always <b>jealous</b> of me.</i>
<b>jealousy</b>	Zealous vigilance-Paul Blanshard. <i>A sharp pang of <b>jealousy</b>.</i>
<b>longing</b>	Prolonged unfulfilled desire or need. <i>Miranda felt a wistful <b>longing</b> for the old days.</i>
<b>lucky</b>	Occurring by chance. <i>A <b>lucky</b> escape.</i>
<b>optimistically</b>	With optimism; in an optimistic manner. <i>He spoke <b>optimistically</b> about what is ahead.</i>
<b>think</b>	An instance of deliberate thinking. <i><b>Think</b> of being paid a salary to hunt big game.</i>
<b>unquenchable</b>	Not able to be quenched. <i>His enthusiasm was <b>unquenchable</b>.</i>
<b>want</b>	Hunt or look for want for a particular reason. <i>He is <b>wanted</b> by the police in connection with an arms theft.</i>
<b>willingness</b>	The quality or state of being prepared to do something; readiness. <i>He expressed his <b>willingness</b> to help.</i>
<b>wish</b>	Order politely express a wish for. <i>I <b>wish</b> I could go home now.</i>
<b>wishing</b>	A specific feeling of desire. <i>He was above all <b>wishing</b> and desire.</i>
<b>yearning</b>	Involving or expressing yearning. <i>He felt a <b>yearning</b> for the mountains.</i>
<b>zeal</b>	Great energy or enthusiasm in pursuit of a cause or an objective. <i>He had an absolute <b>zeal</b> for litigation.</i>
