## Associations of "Horrors" (30 Words)

<a href="#">afraid</a>	Worried that something undesirable will occur or be done. <i>I am <b>afraid</b> we have witnessed only the first phase of the conflict.</i>
<a href="#">alarming</a>	Frightening because of an awareness of danger. <i>Our countryside is disappearing at an <b>alarming</b> rate.</i>
<b>appall</b>	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
<b>browbeat</b>	Be bossy towards. <i>A witness is being <b>browbeaten</b> under cross examination.</i>
<a href="#">chilling</a>	The process of becoming cooler; a falling temperature. <i>A <b>chilling</b> account of the prisoners fate.</i>
<b>claustrophobia</b>	Extreme or irrational fear of confined places. <i>The small stuffy room had begun to give him <b>claustrophobia</b>.</i>
<b>daunt</b>	Make (someone) feel intimidated or apprehensive. <i>Some people are <b>daunted</b> by technology.</i>
<b>fear</b>	Be afraid of (someone or something) as likely to be dangerous, painful, or harmful. <i>Police launched a hunt for the family amid <b>fears</b> for their safety.</i>
<b>fearfulness</b>	The trait of being afraid.
<a href="#">formidable</a>	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>The challenge was <b>formidable</b>.</i>
<b>fright</b>	Frighten. <i>I jumped up in <b>fright</b>.</i>
<b>frighten</b>	Drive out by frightening. <i>The stranger who hangs around the building <b>frightens</b> me.</i>
<a href="#">frightening</a>	The act of inspiring with fear. <i>A <b>frightening</b> experience.</i>

<b><u>gaze</u></b>	Look at with fixed eyes. <i>The male <b>gaze</b>.</i>
<b><u>haunt</u></b>	Haunt like a ghost pursue. <i>She <b>haunts</b> the ballet.</i>
<b><u>horrific</u></b>	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. <b><i>Horrific</i></b> injuries.
<b>intimidate</b>	Make timid or fearful. <i>Her boss <b>intimidates</b> her.</i>
<b><u>panic</u></b>	Feel or cause to feel panic. <i>The students <b>panicked</b> when told that final exams were less than a week away.</i>
<b>petrify</b>	Cause to become stonelike or stiff or dazed and stunned from fright. <i>Slogans <b>petrify</b> our thinking.</i>
<b>phobia</b>	An extreme or irrational fear of or aversion to something. <i>Phobic disorder is a general term for all <b>phobias</b>.</i>
<b>sanguinary</b>	Accompanied by bloodshed. <i>Went after the collaborators with a <b>sanguinary</b> fury that drenched the land with blood.</i>
<b><u>scare</u></b>	Become scared. <i>I don't think I <b>scare</b> easily.</i>
<b>scared</b>	Fearful; frightened. <i>We're both <b>scared</b> of spiders.</i>
<b>scary</b>	Provoking fear terror. <i>A <b>scary</b> movie.</i>
<b><u>startle</u></b>	To stimulate to action. <i>She <b>startled</b> when I walked into the room.</i>
<b>terrible</b>	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>A <b>terrible</b> curse.</i>
<b><u>terrified</u></b>	Thrown into a state of intense fear or desperation. <i>The <b>terrified</b> horse bolted.</i>
<b>terrify</b>	Cause to feel extreme fear. <i>The thought <b>terrifies</b> me.</i>
<b><u>terrifying</u></b>	Causing extreme fear. <i>The <b>terrifying</b> events of the past few weeks.</i>
<b>terror</b>	Terrorism. <i>His delivery is the <b>terror</b> of even world class batsmen.</i>
