Associations of "Horrors" (30 Words)

afraid	Worried that something undesirable will occur or be done. <i>I am afraid we have witnessed only the first phase of the conflict.</i>
alarming	Frightening because of an awareness of danger. <i>Our countryside is disappearing at an alarming rate.</i>
appall	Strike with disgust or revulsion.
browbeat	Be bossy towards. <i>A witness is being browbeaten under cross examination.</i>
chilling	The process of becoming cooler; a falling temperature. <i>A chilling account of the prisoners fate.</i>
claustrophobia	Extreme or irrational fear of confined places. <i>The small stuffy room had begun to give him claustrophobia.</i>
daunt	Make (someone) feel intimidated or apprehensive. <i>Some people are daunted by technology.</i>
fear	Be afraid of (someone or something) as likely to be dangerous, painful, or harmful. <i>Police launched a hunt for the family amid fears for their safety.</i>
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
formidable	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>The challenge was formidable.</i>
fright	Frighten. <i>I jumped up in fright.</i>
frighten	Drive out by frightening. <i>The stranger who hangs around the building frightens me.</i>
frightening	The act of inspiring with fear. <i>A frightening experience.</i>

<u>gaze</u>	Look at with fixed eyes. <i>The male gaze.</i>
<u>haunt</u>	Haunt like a ghost pursue. <i>She haunts the ballet.</i>
<u>horrific</u>	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. Horrific injuries.
intimidate	Make timid or fearful. <i>Her boss intimidates her.</i>
<u>panic</u>	Feel or cause to feel panic. <i>The students panicked when told that final exams were less than a week away.</i>
petrify	Cause to become stonelike or stiff or dazed and stunned from fright. <i>Slogans petrify our thinking.</i>
phobia	An extreme or irrational fear of or aversion to something. <i>Phobic disorder is a general term for all phobias.</i>
sanguinary	Accompanied by bloodshed. <i>Went after the collaborators with a sanguinary fury that drenched the land with blood.</i>
<u>scare</u>	Become scared. <i>I don't think I scare easily.</i>
scared	Fearful; frightened. <i>We're both scared of spiders.</i>
scary	Provoking fear terror. <i>A scary movie.</i>
<u>startle</u>	To stimulate to action. <i>She startled when I walked into the room.</i>
terrible	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>A terrible curse.</i>
<u>terrified</u>	Thrown into a state of intense fear or desperation. <i>The terrified horse bolted.</i>
terrify	Cause to feel extreme fear. <i>The thought terrifies me.</i>
<u>terrifying</u>	Causing extreme fear. <i>The terrifying events of the past few weeks.</i>
terror	Terrorism. <i>His delivery is the terror of even world class batsmen.</i>
