fear	Be afraid of (someone or something) as likely to be dangerous, painful, or harmful. Police launched a hunt for the family amid fear s for their safety.
fearfulness	The trait of being afraid.
<u>formidable</u>	Inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful, intense, or capable. <i>The challenge was formidable</i> .
fright	Frighten. I jumped up in fright .
frighten	Drive out by frightening. The stranger who hangs around the building frighten s me.
<u>frightening</u>	The act of inspiring with fear. A frightening experience.



<u>gaze</u>	Look at with fixed eyes. <i>The male gaze</i> .
<u>haunt</u>	Haunt like a ghost pursue. She haunt s the ballet.
<u>horrific</u>	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. <i>Horrific</i> injuries.
intimidate	Make timid or fearful. Her boss intimidate s her.
<u>panic</u>	Feel or cause to feel panic. The students panic ked when told that final exams were less than a week away.
petrify	Cause to become stonelike or stiff or dazed and stunned from fright. <i>Slogans petrify our thinking.</i>
phobia	An extreme or irrational fear of or aversion to something. Phobic disorder is a general term for all phobia s.
sanguinary	Accompanied by bloodshed. Went after the collaborators with a sanguinary fury that drenched the land with blood.
<u>scare</u>	Become scared. I don t think I scare easily.
scared	Fearful; frightened. We re both scared of spiders.
scary	Provoking fear terror. A scary movie.
<u>startle</u>	To stimulate to action. She startle d when I walked into the room.
terrible	Causing fear or dread or terror. A terrible curse.
<u>terrified</u>	Thrown into a state of intense fear or desperation. The terrified horse bolted.
terrify	Cause to feel extreme fear. The thought terrifies me.
<u>terrifying</u>	Causing extreme fear. The terrifying events of the past few weeks.
terror	Terrorism. His delivery is the terror of even world class batsmen.
