(of porcelain) characterized by a network of fine cracks in the glaze.

Crazed china should not be used for serving food as the tiny cracks can

harbour bacteria.

crazy (of an angle) appearing absurdly out of place or unlikely.

I m **crazy** about Cindy.

dementedBehaving irrationally due to anger, distress, or excitement.

She was **demented** with worry.

frantic Conducted in a hurried, excited, and disorganized way.

She was frantic with worry.

frenzied Excessively agitated; distraught with fear or other violent emotion.

A **frenzied** attack.

Marked by excessive or uncontrollable emotion.

hysterical During **hysterical** conditions various functions of the human body are

disordered.



insane Shocking; outrageous.

He had gone **insane**.

mad Affected with madness or insanity.

A **mad** whirl of pleasure.

maniacal Wildly disordered.

John burst into **maniacal** laughter.

manic (in psychiatry) relating to or affected by mania.

The **manic** interludes in depression.

out of one's mind Outside or external.

raving Used to emphasize a particular quality.

Have you gone raving mad.

wild Produced from wild animals or plants without cultivation.

Her **wild** eyes were darting back and forth.

worked up Getting higher or more vigorous.

wound up Put in a coil.
