Synonyms of "Hyper" as an adjective (15 Words)

crazed	(of porcelain) characterized by a network of fine cracks in the glaze. <i>Crazed china should not be used for serving food as the tiny cracks can harbour bacteria.</i>
crazy	(of an angle) appearing absurdly out of place or unlikely. <i>I m crazy about Cindy.</i>
demented	Behaving irrationally due to anger, distress, or excitement. <i>She was demented with worry.</i>
frantic	Conducted in a hurried, excited, and disorganized way. <i>She was frantic with worry.</i>
frenzied	Excessively agitated; distraught with fear or other violent emotion. <i>A frenzied attack.</i>
hysterical	Marked by excessive or uncontrollable emotion. <i>During hysterical conditions various functions of the human body are disordered.</i>

<u>insane</u>	Shocking; outrageous. <i>He had gone insane.</i>
mad	Affected with madness or insanity. <i>A mad whirl of pleasure.</i>
<u>maniacal</u>	Wildly disordered. <i>John burst into maniacal laughter.</i>
manic	(in psychiatry) relating to or affected by mania. <i>The manic interludes in depression.</i>
out of one's mind	Outside or external.
raving	Used to emphasize a particular quality. <i>Have you gone raving mad.</i>
wild	Produced from wild animals or plants without cultivation. <i>Her wild eyes were darting back and forth.</i>
worked up	Getting higher or more vigorous.
wound up	Put in a coil.
