excellent	Extremely good; outstanding. <i>Their results are excellent.</i>
fine	Characterized by elegance or refinement or accomplishment. <i>This was a fine piece of film making.</i>
good	In a good or proper or satisfactory manner or to a high standard good is a nonstandard dialectal variant for well. <i>Good teeth.</i>
heroism	The qualities of a hero or heroine; exceptional or heroic courage when facing danger (especially in battle). <i>They fought with exemplary heroism.</i>
improving	Getting higher or more vigorous. <i>An improving economy.</i>
meliorate	To make better.
nifty	Particularly good, skilful, or effective. <i>Nifty footwork.</i>
<u>optimize</u>	Modify to achieve maximum efficiency in storage capacity or time or cost. <i>Optimize your resources.</i>

outstanding	Having a quality that thrusts itself into attention. <i>The team's outstanding performance.</i>
phenomenal	Exceedingly or unbelievably great. <i>The phenomenal world.</i>
politely	In a respectful and considerate manner. <i>I politely thanked him for the suggestion.</i>
prudery	Excessive or affected modesty.
refinement	Cultured elegance in behaviour or manner. <i>This gross figure needs considerable refinement.</i>
situated	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely situated on a quiet riverbank.</i>
splendid	Having great beauty and splendor. <i>His robes were splendid.</i>
super	A superintendent. <i>A super quality binder.</i>
superb	Used in names of birds with attractive or colourful plumage e.g. superb lyrebird. <i>The Bey of Tunis was building himself a superb mausoleum.</i>
superlative	The superlative form of an adjective or adverb. <i>The critics lavished superlatives on it.</i>
surpassing	Exceeding or surpassing usual limits especially in excellence. <i>A picture of surpassing beauty.</i>
unsurpassed	Not capable of being improved on. <i>The quality of workmanship is unsurpassed.</i>
vantage	Place or situation affording some advantage especially a comprehensive view or commanding perspective. <i>The past is continuously reinterpreted from the vantage point of the present.</i>
