<b>excellent</b>	Extremely good; outstanding. <i>Their results are <b>excellent</b>.</i>
<b>fine</b>	Characterized by elegance or refinement or accomplishment. <i>This was a <b>fine</b> piece of film making.</i>
<b>good</b>	In a good or proper or satisfactory manner or to a high standard good is a nonstandard dialectal variant for well. <i><b>Good</b> teeth.</i>
<b>heroism</b>	The qualities of a hero or heroine; exceptional or heroic courage when facing danger (especially in battle). <i>They fought with exemplary <b>heroism</b>.</i>
<b>improving</b>	Getting higher or more vigorous. <i>An <b>improving</b> economy.</i>
<b>meliorate</b>	To make better.
<b>nifty</b>	Particularly good, skilful, or effective. <i><b>Nifty</b> footwork.</i>
<b>optimize</b>	Modify to achieve maximum efficiency in storage capacity or time or cost. <i><b>Optimize</b> your resources.</i>

<b>outstanding</b>	Having a quality that thrusts itself into attention. <i>The team's <b>outstanding</b> performance.</i>
<b>phenomenal</b>	Exceedingly or unbelievably great. <i>The <b>phenomenal</b> world.</i>
<b>politely</b>	In a respectful and considerate manner. <i>I <b>politely</b> thanked him for the suggestion.</i>
<b>prudery</b>	Excessive or affected modesty.
<b>refinement</b>	Cultured elegance in behaviour or manner. <i>This gross figure needs considerable <b>refinement</b>.</i>
<b>situated</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely <b>situated</b> on a quiet riverbank.</i>
<b>splendid</b>	Having great beauty and splendor. <i>His robes were <b>splendid</b>.</i>
<b>super</b>	A superintendent. <i>A <b>super</b> quality binder.</i>
<b>superb</b>	Used in names of birds with attractive or colourful plumage e.g superb lyrebird. <i>The Bey of Tunis was building himself a <b>superb</b> mausoleum.</i>
<b>superlative</b>	The superlative form of an adjective or adverb. <i>The critics lavished <b>superlatives</b> on it.</i>
<b>surpassing</b>	Exceeding or surpassing usual limits especially in excellence. <i>A picture of <b>surpassing</b> beauty.</i>
<b>unsurpassed</b>	Not capable of being improved on. <i>The quality of workmanship is <b>unsurpassed</b>.</i>
<b>vantage</b>	Place or situation affording some advantage especially a comprehensive view or commanding perspective. <i>The past is continuously reinterpreted from the <b>vantage</b> point of the present.</i>
