### Definitions of "Iffy" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “iffy” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Subject to accident or chance or change.*
- *Of doubtful quality or legality.*
- *Full of uncertainty; doubtful.*

### Synonyms of "Iffy" as an adjective (16 Words)

<b>chancy</b>	Subject to accident or chance or change. A <b>chancy</b> appeal at best.
<b>flukey</b>	Subject to accident or chance or change.
<b>fluky</b>	Subject to accident or chance or change. A <b>fluky</b> wind.
<b>in doubt</b>	Holding office.
<b>in the balance</b>	Holding office.
<b>low-grade</b>	Of inferior quality.
<b>of low quality</b>	Low or inferior in station or quality.

<b>of poor quality</b>	Having little money or few possessions.
<b>second-rate</b>	Moderate to inferior in quality.
<b>substandard</b>	Falling short of some prescribed norm. <b>Substandard</b> spellings.
<b>tentative</b>	Under terms not final or fully worked out or agreed upon. <i>Just a <b>tentative</b> schedule.</i>
<b>undecided</b>	Not settled or resolved. <i>The match was still <b>undecided</b>.</i>
<b>unreliable</b>	Dangerously unstable and unpredictable. <i>In the early 1950s computers were large and expensive and <b>unreliable</b>.</i>
<b>unresolved</b>	Characterized by musical dissonance harmonically unresolved. <i>Many problems remain <b>unresolved</b>.</i>
<b>unsettled</b>	Worried and uneasy. <i>An <b>unsettled</b> lifestyle.</i>
<b>unsure</b>	(of a fact) not fixed or certain. <i>A very <b>unsure</b> young man.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Iffy" as an adjective

- *An iffy proposition.*
- *The prospect for classes resuming next Wednesday seems iffy.*
- *A good wine merchant will change the iffy bottles for sound ones.*
