- *Of doubtful quality or legality.*
- *Full of uncertainty; doubtful.*

Synonyms of "Iffy" as an adjective (16 Words)

chancy	Subject to accident or chance or change. A chancy appeal at best.
flukey	Subject to accident or chance or change.
fluky	Subject to accident or chance or change. A fluky wind.
in doubt	Holding office.
in the balance	Holding office.
low-grade	Of inferior quality.
of low quality	Low or inferior in station or quality.

of poor quality	Having little money or few possessions.
second-rate	Moderate to inferior in quality.
substandard	Falling short of some prescribed norm. Substandard spellings.
<u>tentative</u>	Under terms not final or fully worked out or agreed upon. <i>Just a tentative schedule.</i>
<u>undecided</u>	Not settled or resolved. <i>The match was still undecided.</i>
unreliable	Dangerously unstable and unpredictable. <i>In the early 1950s computers were large and expensive and unreliable.</i>
unresolved	Characterized by musical dissonance harmonically unresolved. <i>Many problems remain unresolved.</i>
unsettled	Worried and uneasy. <i>An unsettled lifestyle.</i>
<u>unsure</u>	(of a fact) not fixed or certain. <i>A very unsure young man.</i>

Usage Examples of "Iffy" as an adjective

- *An iffy proposition.*
- *The prospect for classes resuming next Wednesday seems iffy.*
- *A good wine merchant will change the iffy bottles for sound ones.*
