## The Forms of Illude

Infinitive	<b>to illude</b>
Present Tense	<b>illude / illudes</b>
Past Tense	<b>illuded</b>
Present Participle	<b>illuding</b>
Past Participle	<b>illuded</b>

## Conjugate Illude

### Illude in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>illude</b>	We <b>illude</b>
You <b>illude</b>	You <b>illude</b>
He/She/It <b>illudes</b>	They <b>illude</b>

## **Illude in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am illuding</b>	We <b>are illuding</b>
You <b>are illuding</b>	You <b>are illuding</b>
He/She/It <b>is illuding</b>	They <b>are illuding</b>

## **Illude in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have illuded</b>	We <b>have illuded</b>
You <b>have illuded</b>	You <b>have illuded</b>
He/She/It <b>has illuded</b>	They <b>have illuded</b>

## **Illude in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been illuding</b>	We <b>have been illuding</b>
You <b>have been illuding</b>	You <b>have been illuding</b>
He/She/It <b>has been illuding</b>	They <b>have been illuding</b>

## **Illude in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>illuded</b>	We <b>illuded</b>
You <b>illuded</b>	You <b>illuded</b>
He/She/It <b>illuded</b>	They <b>illuded</b>

## **Illude in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was illuding</b>	We <b>were illuding</b>
You <b>were illuding</b>	You <b>were illuding</b>
He/She/It <b>was illuding</b>	They <b>were illuding</b>

**Illude in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had illuded</b>	We <b>had illuded</b>
You <b>had illuded</b>	You <b>had illuded</b>
He/She/It <b>had illuded</b>	They <b>had illuded</b>

**Illude in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had been illuding</b>	We <b>had been illuding</b>
You <b>had been illuding</b>	You <b>had been illuding</b>
He/She/It <b>had been illuding</b>	They <b>had been illuding</b>

**Illude in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will illude</b>	We <b>will illude</b>
You <b>will illude</b>	You <b>will illude</b>
He/She/It <b>will illude</b>	They <b>will illude</b>

**Illude in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be illuding</b>	We <b>will be illuding</b>
You <b>will be illuding</b>	You <b>will be illuding</b>
He/She/It <b>will be illuding</b>	They <b>will be illuding</b>

**Illude in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have illuded**

**We will have illuded**

**You will have illuded**

**You will have illuded**

**He/She/It will have illuded**

**They will have illuded**

**Illude in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been illuding**

**We will have been illuding**

**You will have been illuding**

**You will have been illuding**

**He/She/It will have been illuding**

**They will have been illuding**
