
Illustrative as an Adjective

Synonyms of "Illustrative" as an adjective (7 Words)

demonstrative Involving demonstration, especially by scientific means. We were a very physically **demonstrative** family.

elucidative That makes clear.

exegetic Relating to exegesis.

exemplifying Clarifying by use of examples.

Serving or intended to explain or make clear. explanatory

An **explanatory** paragraph.

Intended to explain or describe something. expository

An **expository** prologue.

Relating to or providing an interpretation. interpretative

Activities designed to reinforce students **interpretative** skills.
