Synonyms of "Illustrative" as an adjective (7 Words)

- demonstrative** Involving demonstration, especially by scientific means.
*We were a very physically **demonstrative** family.*
- elucidative** That makes clear.
- exegetic** Relating to exegesis.
- exemplifying** Clarifying by use of examples.
- explanatory** Serving or intended to explain or make clear.
*An **explanatory** paragraph.*
- expository** Intended to explain or describe something.
*An **expository** prologue.*
- interpretative** Relating to or providing an interpretation.
*Activities designed to reinforce students **interpretative** skills.*
