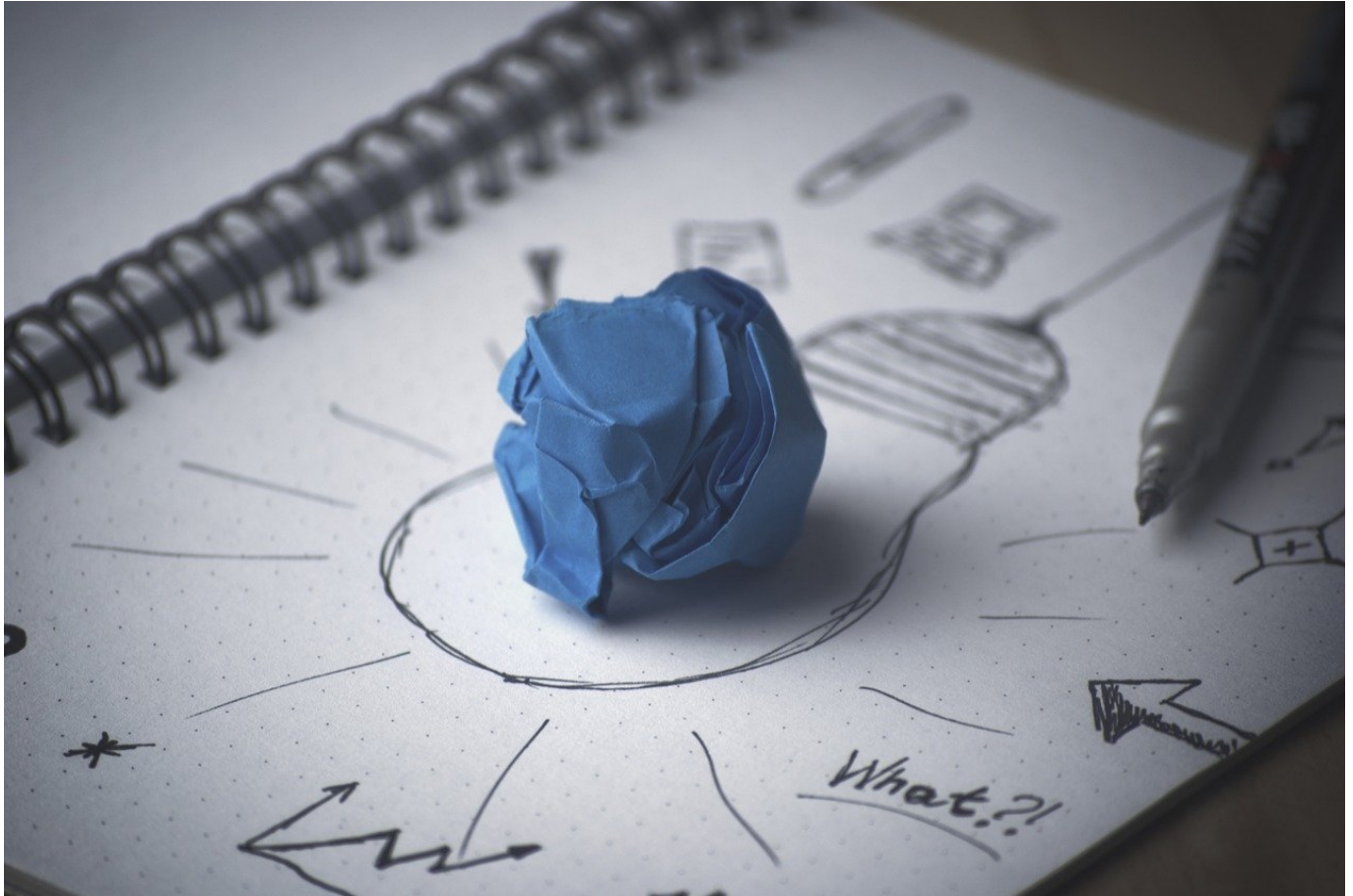

- *Having or showing creativity or inventiveness.*

Thinking about or planning the future with imagination or wisdom.  
**Visionary** dreams.

The first part or earliest stage of something.  
*They had reached the **beginning** of the wood.*

### **brainstorming**

A group problem-solving technique in which members spontaneously share ideas and solutions.  
*A **brainstorming** session.*

<b><u>groundbreaking</u></b>	Innovative; pioneering. <b>Groundbreaking</b> research into fertility problems.
<b>idea</b>	The aim or purpose. <i>I took a job with the <b>idea</b> of getting some money together.</i>
<b><u>inception</u></b>	An event that is a beginning; a first part or stage of subsequent events. <i>She has been on the board since its <b>inception</b> two years ago.</i>
<b><u>incipient</u></b>	Beginning to happen or develop. <b>Incipient</b> civil disorder.
<b>ingenious</b>	Showing inventiveness and skill. <i>He was <b>ingenious</b> enough to overcome the limited budget.</i>
<b>initial</b>	Mark with one s initials. <i>The witness was identified simply by an <b>initial</b> letter.</i>
<b>initially</b>	At first. <b>Initially</b> he thought the new concept was nonsense.
<b>innovation</b>	A creation (a new device or process) resulting from study and experimentation. <b>Innovation</b> is crucial to the continuing success of any organization.
<b>innovative</b>	Ahead of the times. <i>Stylistically <b>innovative</b> works.</i>
<b><u>invention</u></b>	Creative ability. <i>His powers of <b>invention</b> were rather limited.</i>

<b><u>inventive</u></b>	Showing creativity or original thought. <i>Had an <b>inventive</b> turn of mind.</i>
<b>new</b>	Newly recently. <i>Grass <b>new</b> washed by the rain.</i>
<b><u>novelty</u></b>	A new or unfamiliar thing or experience. <i>In 1914 air travel was still a <b>novelty</b>.</i>
<b><u>original</u></b>	An original creation i e an audio recording from which copies can be made. <i>His work is based on only <b>original</b> not secondary sources.</i>
<b><u>originality</u></b>	The ability to think independently and creatively. <i>He congratulated her on the <b>originality</b> of her costume.</i>
<b>prototype</b>	Make a prototype of a product. <i>The firm is testing a <b>prototype</b> of the weapon.</i>
<b>superbly</b>	In an impressively splendid manner. <i>A <b>superbly</b> gifted writer.</i>
<b>unabridged</b>	(used of texts) not shortened. <i>An <b>unabridged</b> edition.</i>
<b><u>wonderfully</u></b>	In a way that inspires delight or admiration; extremely well. <i>A <b>wonderfully</b> entertaining show.</i>
