Infinitive	to impair
Present Tense	impair / impairs
Past Tense	impaired
Present Participle	impairing
Past Participle	impaired

# **Conjugate Impair**

#### **Impair in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>impair</b>	We <b>impair</b>
You <b>impair</b>	You <b>impair</b>
He/She/It <b>impairs</b>	They <b>impair</b>

### **Impair in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am impairing	We <b>are impairing</b>
You <b>are impairing</b>	You <b>are impairing</b>
He/She/It is impairing	They are impairing

#### **Impair in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have impaired	We have impaired
You <b>have impaired</b>	You have impaired
He/She/It has impaired	They have impaired

### **Impair in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been impairing	We have been impairing
You <b>have been impairing</b>	You have been impairing
He/She/It has been impairing	They have been impairing

### **Impair in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I impaired	We <b>impaired</b>
You <b>impaired</b>	You <b>impaired</b>
He/She/It <b>impaired</b>	They <b>impaired</b>

#### **Impair in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was impairing	We were impairing
You <b>were impairing</b>	You were impairing
He/She/It was impairing	They were impairing

#### **Impair in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had impaired	We had impaired
You <b>had impaired</b>	You had impaired
He/She/It had impaired	They had impaired

#### **Impair in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been impairing	We had been impairing
You <b>had been impairing</b>	You <b>had been impairing</b>
He/She/It had been impairing	They had been impairing

## **Impair in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will impair</b>	We <b>will impair</b>
You <b>will impair</b>	You <b>will impair</b>
He/She/It will impair	They will impair

## **Impair in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be impairing	We <b>will be impairing</b>
You <b>will be impairing</b>	You will be impairing
He/She/It will be impairing	They will be impairing

#### **Impair in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have impairedWe will have impairedYou will have impairedYou will have impairedHe/She/It will have impairedThey will have impaired

#### **Impair in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been impairing	We <b>will have been impairing</b>
You <b>will have been impairing</b>	You <b>will have been impairing</b>
He/She/It will have been impairing	They will have been impairing
