Present Tense	improvisate / improvisates
Past Tense	improvisated
Present Participle	improvisating
Past Participle	improvisated

Conjugate Improvisate

Improvisate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **improvisate** We **improvisate**
You **improvisate** You **improvisate**
He/She/It **improvisates** They **improvisate**

Improvisate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am improvisating** We **are improvisating**
You **are improvisating** You **are improvisating**
He/She/It **is improvisating** They **are improvisating**

Improvisate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have improvisated** We **have improvisated**
You **have improvisated** You **have improvisated**
He/She/It **has improvisated** They **have improvisated**

Improvisate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been improvisating** We **have been improvisating**
You **have been improvisating** You **have been improvisating**
He/She/It **has been improvisating** They **have been improvisating**

Improvisate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **improvisated** We **improvisated**
You **improvisated** You **improvisated**
He/She/It **improvisated** They **improvisated**

Improvisate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was improvisating We were improvisating
You were improvisating You were improvisating
He/She/It was improvisating They were improvisating

Improvisate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had improvisated We had improvisated
You had improvisated You had improvisated
He/She/It had improvisated They had improvisated

Improvisate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been improvisating We had been improvisating
You had been improvisating You had been improvisating
He/She/It had been improvisating They had been improvisating

Improvisate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will improvisate We will improvisate
You will improvisate You will improvisate
He/She/It will improvisate They will improvisate

Improvisate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be improvisating We will be improvisating
You will be improvisating You will be improvisating
He/She/It will be improvisating They will be improvisating

Improvisate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have improvisated

We will have improvisated

You will have improvisated

You will have improvisated

He/She/It will have improvisated

They will have improvisated

Improvisate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been improvisating

We will have been improvisating

You will have been improvisating

You will have been improvisating

He/She/It will have been improvisating

They will have been improvisating
