| aperture | A space through which light passes in an optical or photographic instrument, especially the variable opening by which light enters a camera. <i>A refracting telescope with an aperture of 3 inches.</i> |
| assimilation | The absorption and digestion of food or nutrients by the body or any biological system. <i>There are many assimilations and elisions of consonants and vowels.</i> |
| disembodied | Not having a material body. <i>A disembodied voice at the end of the phone.</i> |
| enclosed | (of a religious order or other community) secluded from the outside world. <i>An enclosed yard.</i> |
| entree | The act of entering. <i>She made a graceful entree into the ballroom.</i> |
| furnishing | The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>The furnishing comprised three easy chairs and one oval table.</i> |
| groove | Make a groove or grooves in. <i>His thoughts were slipping into a familiar groove.</i> |
| indoor | Relating to sports played indoors. <i>Indoor sports.</i> |
| indoors | Into or within a building. <i>They went indoors and explored the house.</i> |

| inland | Towards or into the interior of a region. <i>The inland port of Gloucester.</i> |
| inmost | Innermost. |
| inner | Innermost or essential. <i>Inner regions of the organization.</i> |
| inside | The region that is inside of something. <i>They were accused of selling shares while in possession of inside information.</i> |
| insider | A person within a group or organization, especially someone privy to information unavailable to others. <i>Political insiders.</i> |
| interior | The inland part of a country or region. <i>Interior regions of the earth.</i> |
| internal | Of or situated on the inside. <i>All the weapon s internals are well finished and highly polished.</i> |
| intramural | Forming part of normal university or college studies. <i>Recreational intramural games.</i> |
| inward | Directed or moving inward or toward a center. <i>A concern with inward reflections.</i> |
| inwardly | Within the mind. <i>Inwardly seething he did as he was told.</i> |
| located | Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally located urban land.</i> |
| mural | Of or relating to walls. <i>A mural escarpment.</i> |
| opening | The act of opening something. <i>Maya started tapping out the opening of her story.</i> |
| position | A proposition laid down or asserted a tenet or assertion. <i>I had positioned her as my antagonist.</i> |
| reserved | Marked by self-restraint and reticence. <i>A reserved seat.</i> |
| therein | In that place, document, or respect. <i>It shall be sufficient evidence of the facts therein contained.</i> |
| trapped | Forced to turn and face attackers. <i>Like a trapped animal.</i> |
| upstage | Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>This upstage reserve is rather ridiculous.</i> |
