<b>entree</b>	The right to enter. <i>She made a graceful <b>entree</b> into the ballroom.</i>
<b>however</b>	To whatever degree or extent. <i><b>However</b> you look at it you can t criticize that.</i>
<b><a href="#">indicative</a></b>	The indicative mood. <i>Actions <b>indicative</b> of fear.</i>
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i><b>Indoor</b> sports.</i>
<b>indoors</b>	Within a building. <i>They went <b>indoors</b> and explored the house.</i>
<b>inflect</b>	Of a word or language undergo inflection. <i>Her analysis may have been <b>inflected</b> by the upsurge of feminism.</i>
<b>inmost</b>	Situated or occurring farthest within.

<b>inner</b>	A shot that strikes the inner. <i>An <b>inner</b> courtyard.</i>
<b>inside</b>	On the inside. <i>He reached into his <b>inside</b> jacket pocket.</i>
<b>interior</b>	Situated further in or within. <i>The plains of the <b>interior</b>.</i>
<b><u>internal</u></b>	Relating to affairs and activities within a country rather than with other countries; domestic. <i><b>Internal</b> bleeding.</i>
<b>intramural</b>	Taking place within a single educational institution. <i>An <b>intramural</b> social symbol within the tribe.</i>
<b>inwardly</b>	Within the mind. <i><b>Inwardly</b> seething he did as he was told.</i>
<b>locative</b>	The locative case.
<b>noun</b>	A word other than a pronoun used to identify any of a class of people places or things common noun or to name a particular one of these proper noun.
<b>participle</b>	A word formed from a verb e g going gone being been and used as an adjective e g working woman burnt toast or a noun e g good breeding In English participles are also used to make compound verb forms e g is going has been.
<b><u>predicate</u></b>	What is predicated of the subject of a proposition the second term in a proposition is predicated of the first term by means of the copula. <i>The <b>predicate</b> dog is <b>predicated</b> of the subject Fido in the sentence Fido is a dog.</i>
<b>prefix</b>	Add a prefix or introduction to something. <i>All three digit numbers will now be <b>prefixed</b> by 580.</i>
<b>pronoun</b>	A function word that is used in place of a noun or noun phrase.
<b>suffix</b>	Attach a suffix to. <i><b>Suffix</b> words.</i>
<b><u>suggestive</u></b>	Tending to suggest something improper or indecent. <i>There were various <b>suggestive</b> pieces of evidence.</i>
<b>verb</b>	Use a word that is not conventionally used as a verb typically a noun as a verb. <i>Any English noun can be <b>verbed</b> but some are more resistant than others.</i>
<b>within</b>	Internally or inwardly. <i>Enquire <b>within</b>.</i>
