<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>The national <b>indoor</b> champion.</i>
<b>indoors</b>	Within a building. <i>The rain makes <b>indoors</b> feel so warm and safe.</i>
<b>inflect</b>	Of a word or language undergo inflection. <i>Blues <b>inflected</b> bar rock.</i>
<b>inmost</b>	Innermost.
<b>inner</b>	A shot that strikes the inner. <i>The <b>inner</b> logic of Cubism.</i>

<b>inside</b>	On the inside. <i>The <b>inside</b> of the bend.</i>
<b>interior</b>	(in filming) indoor. <i>The <b>interior</b> has been much restored.</i>
<b>internal</b>	Inside the body. <i>The <b>internal</b> contradictions of the theory.</i>
<b>intramural</b>	Situated within the wall of a hollow organ or a cell. <i>An <b>intramural</b> social symbol within the tribe.</i>
<b>inwardly</b>	With respect to private feelings. <i><b>Inwardly</b> seething he did as he was told.</i>
<b>locative</b>	A word in the locative case.
<b>noun</b>	A word other than a pronoun used to identify any of a class of people places or things common noun or to name a particular one of these proper noun.
<b>participle</b>	A word formed from a verb e g going gone being been and used as an adjective e g working woman burnt toast or a noun e g good breeding In English participles are also used to make compound verb forms e g is going has been.
<b>predicate</b>	Logic what is predicated of the subject of a proposition the second term in a proposition is predicated of the first term by means of the copula. <i>Solving the problem is <b>predicated</b> on understanding it well.</i>
<b>prefix</b>	Attach a prefix to. <i>A preface is <b>prefixed</b> to the book.</i>
<b>pronoun</b>	A word that can function as a noun phrase used by itself and that refers either to the participants in the discourse (e.g. I, you) or to someone or something mentioned elsewhere in the discourse (e.g. she, it, this).
<b>suffix</b>	Append something especially as a suffix. <i><b>Suffix</b> words.</i>
<b>suggestive</b>	Making someone think of sexual matters. <i><b>Suggestive</b> poses.</i>
<b>verb</b>	Use a word that is not conventionally used as a verb typically a noun as a verb. <i>Any English noun can be <b>verbed</b> but some are more resistant than others.</i>
<b>within</b>	Internally or inwardly. <i>Beauty coming from <b>within</b>.</i>
<b>word</b>	Express something spoken or written in particular words. <i>Her father would have had <b>words</b> with her about that.</i>
