glow	Light from nonthermal sources. The coals were glow ing in the dark.
illuminate	Decorate (a building or structure) with lights for a special occasion. Placing the events of the 1930s in a broader historical context helps to illuminate their significance.
illumination	A condition of spiritual awareness divine illumination. <i>Higher levels of illumination are needed for reading</i> .
illumine	Light up; brighten. He moved her lamp so that her face was illumine d.
infrared	Of equipment or techniques using or concerned with infrared radiation. <i>Infrared</i> photography.
phosphorescent	The phosphorescent glow of decaying wood.
radiance	An attractive combination of good health and happiness. <i>Restore your skin s natural radiance.</i>
radiant	A radiant point. Don t assume that you should stare toward the radiant to see the most meteors.
radiation	The energy transmitted by radiation. Evolution is a process of radiation not progression.
