## Associations of "In short" (30 Words)

<b>abbreviate</b>	Shorten. <i>Network is often <b>abbreviated</b> to net.</i>
<b>abbreviated</b>	Very short. <i>The <b>abbreviated</b> speech.</i>
<b>abbreviation</b>	A shortened form of a word or phrase. <i>SKU is the <b>abbreviation</b> for Stock Keeping Unit.</i>
<b>abscond</b>	(of a colony of honeybees, especially Africanized ones) entirely abandon a hive or nest. <i>The barman <b>absconded</b> with a week s takings.</i>
<b><a href="#">brief</a></b>	Instruct a barrister by brief. <i>The president made a <b>brief</b> working visit to Moscow.</i>
<b><a href="#">concise</a></b>	Expressing much in few words. <i>A <b>concise</b> account of the country s history.</i>
<b>ephemeral</b>	An ephemeral plant. <i>Chickweed is an <b>ephemeral</b> weed producing several generations in one season.</i>
<b><a href="#">fleeting</a></b>	Lasting for a markedly brief time. <i>For a <b>fleeting</b> moment I saw the face of a boy.</i>
<b>fugitive</b>	A person who has escaped from captivity or is in hiding. <i>The <b>fugitive</b> effects of light.</i>
<b><a href="#">insufficient</a></b>	Not enough; inadequate. <i><b>Insufficient</b> funds.</i>
<b>interlude</b>	Perform an interlude. <i>An orchestral <b>interlude</b>.</i>
<b>lacking</b>	(of a quality) absent. <i>Her appetite was <b>lacking</b>.</i>

<b>momentary</b>	Lasting for a very short time; brief. <i>A <b>momentary</b> glimpse.</i>
<b>overview</b>	Give a general review or summary of. <i>A brief <b>overview</b> of the survey.</i>
<b>paucity</b>	The presence of something in only small or insufficient quantities or amounts. <i>A <b>paucity</b> of information.</i>
<b>provisional</b>	A provisional stamp. <i>Norman as yet had only a <b>provisional</b> licence.</i>
<b>provisory</b>	Provisional. <i>A <b>provisory</b> clause.</i>
<b>scant</b>	Barely sufficient or adequate. <i>A <b>scant</b> cup of sugar.</i>
<b>sojourn</b>	Spend a certain length of time; reside temporarily. <i>Her <b>sojourn</b> in Rome.</i>
<b>stopgap</b>	A temporary way of dealing with a problem or satisfying a need. <i>Transplants are only a <b>stopgap</b> until more sophisticated alternatives can work.</i>
<b>stopover</b>	A break in a journey. <i>Easy vehicle access makes the spot a favourite <b>stopover</b> for camper vanners.</i>
<b>succinct</b>	Briefly giving the gist of something. <i>Use short <b>succinct</b> sentences.</i>
<b>summary</b>	A brief statement that presents the main points in a concise form. <i><b>Summary</b> justice.</i>
<b>temporary</b>	A person employed on a temporary basis typically an office worker who finds employment through an agency. <i>Employed on a <b>temporary</b> basis.</i>
<b>terse</b>	Sparing in the use of words; abrupt. <i>A <b>terse</b> statement.</i>
<b>transient</b>	Staying or working in a place for a short time only. <i>A <b>transient</b> cold spell.</i>
<b>transitory</b>	Lasting a very short time. <i>Love is <b>transitory</b> but it is eternal.</i>
<b>truce</b>	A state of peace agreed to between opponents so they can discuss peace terms. <i>The guerrillas called a three day <b>truce</b>.</i>

**truncate**      Approximate by ignoring all terms beyond a chosen one.  
*The torso has been **truncated** just below the neck line.*

**wanting**      Lacking in a required or necessary quality.  
*Mandibles are **wanting** in many of these insects.*
